Exhibitors and owners of Jack Russell Terriers must be current JRTCA members. JRTCA membership does not apply to owners of other dog breeds.

GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10"-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered..
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. This rule also applies to RV's and campers if at the same address as the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site.
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book may be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website www.therealjackrussell.com
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease. *Attending with proof of vaccinations is strongly recommended.*
- 23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape or use cell phones while judging their event.
- 24. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.

Notice To Exhibitors - NO LOOSE DOGS!

- 1. KEEP TERRIERS AWAY FROM THE REGISTRATION TABLE!
- 2. **NO FLEXI LEADS.** 4' or 6' leashes only permitted on trial site. Be mindful of where your dog is at all times.
- 3. A copy of your 2024 JRTCA Membership certificate and copies of Certificates in Championship GTG, Super Earth, and Working terriers must be submitted with your entries, emailed before the trial, or presented to the Trial Secretary at the Registration table. Failure to provide these items will result in your terrier/s not being allowed to compete.
- 4. Children (this includes participating Child Handlers) require adult supervision at all times.
- 5. Please travel with your health records for ALL your terriers and have a signed rabies certificate from your vet.
- 6. <u>ABSOLUTELY NO PUPPIES UNDER 3 MONTHS OLD</u>. Questions as to age of puppies will be resolved in favor of the puppies' general well-being, and you will be asked to remove them from all areas of the trial site, including RV area. <u>The decision of the Trial Chair is final.</u>
- 7. Well-behaved, restrained "alternative breeds" may attend with approval from a Trial Administrator. Please contact the Trial Administrator for permission (or enter events). Dogs not competing will not be permitted within 50 feet of any event.
- 8. Exhibitors must sign the waiver when submitting entry forms.
- 9. No refunds will be given for missed classes. Pay attention, and if you need help handling dogs... Ask for it!
- 10. Any exhibitor found to be in violation of any of these policies will be disqualified and no refund given.
- 11. No grooming at ringside! Please limit grooming at the trial site. Grooming at hotels/motels is not allowed.
- 12. While marijuana is legal for medicinal and recreational purposes in the State of Washington, it is not permitted to be consumed in public. It is only allowed on private property, out of the view of the public. If you wish to partake, YOU MUST do so OFF the property of Flying M, even if in your vehicle or RV.
- 13. There will be a nominal fee of \$10 for paper entries if you elect to use this format instead of our online entry platform at www.v3.triavault.dog.
- 14. Conformation ring is located indoors, in a covered arena. No EZ ups indoors.
- 15. **Non-Registered/Non-Recorded Terriers**: Non-registered or non-recorded Jack Russell Terriers can participate in all sanctioned trials (with the exception of the National Trial) as long as their owners are current JRTCA members. They must pay, in addition to the regular \$2/terrier/day administration fee, an additional \$5/terrier/day administration fee. Not applicable to "other earth dogs" entering non-sanctioned classes.

Formerly known as "CERF" exams, we are excited to be able to offer this service at our trial! Dr Nathan Kice, DVM, veterinary ophthalmologist will be available on Sunday to perform these exams. Please fill out the required paperwork prior to presentation no less than 24 hours prior to your appointment. Please be sure to go to www.ofa.org.online to create an owner account, if you do not already have one. In your account, select the blue box to create a new application. Fill in the online version of the application form. Select the box for "Online Exams" with CAER Eye listed. For veterinarian info, select Dr Nathan Kice.

Your exam may be denied if you do not have your forms completed upon presentation for examination.

The fee for each exam will be \$45 per dog. We need a minimum of thirty dogs to pre-register in order to be able to offer this service. Dogs do not need to be participating in the trial to be examined, though competitors will have first choice of appointment time.

ALL terriers must be muzzled to race with either a plastic basket or close-ended cloth muzzle. No figure-8 or open-ended muzzles allowed. No colored muzzles. No Baskerville muzzles.

To be eligible for the Championship, terriers must have entered and <u>finished</u> both flats & hurdles. A Finished race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier. Any terrier racing without a secure muzzle will be disqualified. No refund will be given.

Adult terriers MAY NOT CROSS ENTER between Adult, Veteran, and Senior Racing classes. SEE POSTED RACING RULES! Championship classes have no entry fee.

You MUST have your dog ON DECK and securely muzzled in order to race. <u>If you need help, please ask for it in advance. DO NOT</u> wait until it's time to load into the starting boxes. BE PREPARED. <u>Racing classes will be run in the precise sequence posted in this trial premium, except at the discretion of the racing judge, to accommodate re-runs and multiple heats, for the safety of our terriers.</u>

<u>Class 44:</u> Child Handler – Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older This class is offered as an experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.

<u>Class 45:</u> Child Go-To-Ground - Children will run the tunnels prior to GTG opening for adults. Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT, six months or older. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before It can compete in Child Go-To-Ground. (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 46: Child Handler High Score & Reserve - Awarded to the highest scoring Child Handler and runner-up in classes 44 & 45. The points are awarded as follows: $1 \le 8$; $2 \le 6$; $3 \le 5$; $4 \le 4$; $5 \le 9$ place = 3; $6 \le 9$ place = 2; and participation = 1 point. (Non-Sanctioned, no entry fee)

<u>Class 47:</u> Youth Handler – Immediately following Child Handler. Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

<u>Class 48:</u> Youth Go-To-Ground - Youth will run the tunnels prior to GTG opening for adults. Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10 ft. novice tunnel. Time NOT to be considered. If the terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before it can compete in Youth GTG.

<u>Class 49:</u> Youth Working Judge's Choice - Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult JRT. Judged on the Youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, an ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class

<u>Class 50:</u> <u>Youth Handler High Score & Reserve</u> – Awarded to the highest scoring Youth and runner-up in classes 47, 48, and 49. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th place = 3 points, 6th place = 2 points, and participation = 1 point.

Child Exhibitors must compete in both Child Handler & Child GTG in order to qualify for the Child Handler High Score & Reserve (Non-Sanctioned). Youth Exhibitors must compete in Youth Handler and Youth GTG in order to qualify for the Youth High Score & Reserve. In the case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring; Judge to be decided by the Trial Chair.

- Class 57: Bred By Exhibitor Working Terrier Bitch Open to any Working JRT owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.
- Class 58: Working Terrier Bitch 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 59: Working Terrier Bitch over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 60: BEST WORKING TERRIER BITCH & RESERVE. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 56-59.
- <u>Class 61:</u> <u>WORKING TERRIER CHAMPION & RESERVE.</u> Open to Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve and Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve from classes 55 and 60.

Section 2: MISCELLANEOUS CONFORMATION (ALL classes are SANCTIONED and judged on breed standard, unless noted)

- <u>Class 62:</u> Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier Open to any spayed/neutered JRTCA registered terrier owned by a member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. No Cross-Entering into Working or Open classes.

Section 5: OPEN ADULT CONFORMATION

Classes may be split by coat if entries warrant it. "Best" classes have no entry fee.

Class 83: Bred by Exhibitor Dog

<u>Class 84</u>: Dogs 1 yr. & Older 10" up to 12.5" <u>Class 85</u>: Dogs 1 yr. & Older over 12.5" up to 15"

Class 86: BEST OPEN DOG & RESERVE. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 83-85.

Class 87: Bred By Exhibitor Bitch

Class 88: Bitches 1 yr. & Older 10" up to 12.5"

Class 89: Bitches 1 yr. & Older over 12.5" up to 15"

Class 90: BEST OPEN BITCH & RESERVE. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 87-89.

Class 91: BEST OPEN TERRIER & RESERVE. Open to Best Dog & Reserve and Best Bitch & Reserve from classes 86 & 90.

Section 6: FAMILY CLASSES

Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type, offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Class 92: Stud Dog & Get. Open to sire with at least 2, but no more than 3, offspring at side. Stud dog must be intact.

<u>Class 93</u>: Brood Bitch and Produce. Open to dam with at least 2, but no more than 3, offspring at side. Brood bitch must be intact.

Class 94: BEST FAMILY & RESERVE. Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 92-93

DIVISION D: GO-TO-GROUND

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying). For Championship Certificate classes, no adult terrier may compete in any GTG Certificate class unless a Trial Certificate has been applied for, issued, AND presented to the Trial Secretary with submission of entry forms or at trial. No cross entering between Certificate classes.

A line approximately two feet from the entrance hole will be designated as the starting line. Time starts when the terrier crosses the starting line. The terrier is to be released so that all four of the terrier's feet are on the ground before crossing the starting line. After releasing the terrier, the handler should remain at the starting line and cannot touch the terrier or block the tunnel after terrier has entered the tunnel.

Timing is as follows:

Novice Puppy & Novice Adult - One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Open Puppy & Open Adult - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; must work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Puppy Championship - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

<u>Championship Certificate Classes</u> - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

CHILD/YOUTH GTG BEGINS AT 9AM. GTG IS OPEN TO EXHIBITORS AT 10AM; IF A YOUTH STILL NEEDS TO RUN, THEY TAKE PRIORITY

If a terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before It can compete in Youth Go-To-Ground.

<u>Class 95:</u> <u>PRE-NOVICE PUPPY</u> Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 mos. Entry in pre-novice class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice class after 6 mos. of age. (One minute to reach quarry, may leave earth and re-enter, mark quarry for a full 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

<u>Class 96:</u> <u>NOVICE PUPPY</u> Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 mos. which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open Puppy class at this trial. (1 minute to reach quarry, may leave earth & re-enter several times, work quarry for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 97: NOVICE ADULT Open to JRT's 1 yr. or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open Adult class at this trial. (1 minute to reach quarry, may leave earth & re-enter several times, work quarry for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

If a terrier has passed the Novice Puppy class or Novice Adult class, the terrier may not enter ANY Novice class ever again. Terriers must be recorded or registered to participate in Certificate classes.

<u>Class 98: OPEN PUPPY</u> Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.) <u>Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.</u>

<u>Class 99:</u> <u>OPEN ADULT</u> Open to JRT's, one year or older, which have scored 100% in a Novice GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. <u>MAY NOT enter the Championship Certificate Class at this trial</u>. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry, may leave earth once and reenter, work quarry for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another).

<u>Class 100: PUPPY CHAMPIONSHIP GTG</u> Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 mos. who have earned 100% in an Open Puppy GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% open score sheet must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Puppy GTG Champion & Reserve. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once & re-enter, work quarry for 1 full minute without a break in work and without leaving the quarry, may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

1st & 2nd place winners of Certificate classes will be GTG Champion & Reserve.

<u>Class 101:</u> <u>10" up to 12.5" CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG</u>. Open to any adult JRT 10" to 12.5" who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross entering is not permitted between the Certificate classes.

<u>Class 102:</u> <u>Over 12.5" up to 15" CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG</u>. Open to any JRT over 12.5" up to 15" who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross entering is not permitted between Certificate classes.

<u>Class 103:</u> <u>10" up to 12.5" VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG</u>. Open to any JRT 6 yrs. or older, 10" to 12.5", which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes.

<u>Class 104:</u> <u>Over 12.5" up to 15" VETERAN CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG</u>. Open to any JRT 6 yrs. or older, over 12.5" up to 15", which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes.

<u>Class 105:</u> <u>SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE GTG</u>. Open to any JRT 9 yrs. or older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. Cross-entering is not permitted between Certificate classes.

Class 106: Novice Other Earthdog. Open to any terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, 4 months of age or older. NON-SANCTIONED

Class 107: Open Other Earthdog Puppy. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, 4-12 months of age. NON-SANCTIONED

<u>Class 108:</u> Open Other Earthdog Adult. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, one year of age or over. **NON-SANCTIONED**

DIVISION E: SUPER EARTH

Please note that your terrier must reach the guarry within the allotted time designated by the length of the tunnels.

A challenging go-to-ground course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another without penalty (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying). For Championship Certificate classes, a copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown. Classes may be combined as entries warrant. A line approximately two feet from the entrance hole will be designated as the starting line. Time starts when the terrier crosses the starting line. The terrier is to be released so that all four of the terrier's feet are on the ground before crossing the starting line. After releasing the terrier, the handler should remain at the starting line and cannot touch the terrier or block the tunnel after terrier has entered the tunnel.

Timing for all Super Earth classes: One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter the earth multiple times until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work. Terrier is not to leave quarry once reached.

<u>Class 109:</u> 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Super Earth. Open to JRT puppies 6 to 12 months. Puppies who have earned 100% in the Open Puppy Super Earth Class at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee enter the Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial **OR** may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth class at future trials. Winners of the Puppy Championship Super Earth will determine the Puppy Super Earth Champion & Reserve. *Open Puppy Super Earth Class is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth, at any trial.*

Class 110: 10" up to 12.5" Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 111: Over 12.5" up to 15" Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 112: 10" up to 12.5" Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 113: Over 12.5" up to 15" Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older.

<u>Class 114:</u> <u>6 UP TO 12 MONTH PUPPY SUPER EARTH CHAMPIONSHIP</u>. Open to JRTs 6 up to 12 mos. which have earned 100% in an Open Puppy class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% open score sheet must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be 6 up to 12 month Puppy Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 115: 10" up to 12.5" ADULT CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any adult JRT 1 yr. & older, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Adult Under Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

<u>Class 116:</u> <u>Over 12.5" up to 15" ADULT CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH</u>. Open to any adult JRT 1 yr. & older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to the Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Adult Over Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

<u>Class 117:</u> <u>10" up to 12.5" VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH</u>. Open to any JRT 6 years or older which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Under Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

<u>Class 118:</u> <u>Over 12.5" up to 15" VETERAN CHAMPION CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH.</u> Open to any JRT 6 years or older, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Veteran Over Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 119: SENIOR CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE SUPER EARTH. Open to any JRT 9 years or older, which holds a JRTCA Super Earth Certificate. A copy of Certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or shown to Den Steward at time of class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Class 120: Open Other Earthdog Puppy. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, 6-12 months of age. NON-SANCTIONED

<u>Class 121:</u> Open Other Earthdog Adult. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, one year of age or over. **NON-SANCTIONED**

DIVISION F: TRAILING & LOCATING

(ONE FREE FUN RUN FOR YOUTH)

Can your canine follow the trail to the hidden rat in the canister? This is an event where placement depends on both time and the ability to closely follow a scented trail. Judged on the ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment to locate, mark, and open on the "quarry." Animal is judged on a combination of time and accuracy. Youth fun runs must be AFTER official class.

Class 122: Puppies, JRTs, 6 up to 12 months

Class 123: Adults, JRTs one year and older

Class 124: Brace, two adult JRTs working as a team.

Class 125: Other Earthdog Puppy. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, aged 6-12 months. NON-SANCTIONED

Class 126: Other Earthdog. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT. NON-SANCTIONED

Class 127: Other Canine. Open to any breed other than a JRT. NON-SANCTIONED

DIVISION G: NON-SANCTIONED FUN EVENTS

Section 1: LURE COURSING (Non-Sanctioned - Muzzles Strongly Recommended)

(YOUTH WILL HAVE TWO FREE FUN RUNS)

This is a timed event in which the terrier chases a lure in an enclosed fenced course. Each dog will be running individually and will get two runs. No experience necessary. Enter as many times as you like. Class fee for 2 qualifying runs for a 1-6 ribbon placement; sign up on entry form or at the Registration Desk. Fun runs available directly from the judge, 2 for \$5 Youth fun runs must be AFTER official class.

Class 128: Puppies 6 up to 12 months

Class 129: Adults 10" up to 12.5"

Class 130: Adults over 12.5" up to 15"

Class 131: Veterans (6+ years) 10" up to 12.5"

Class 132: Veterans (6+ years) over 12.5" up to 15".

<u>Class 133:</u> Other Earthdog Puppy. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, aged 6-12 months.

Class 134: Other Earthdog. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT.

Class 135: Other Canine. Open to any breed other than a JRT.

Section 2: BRUSH HUNT (Non-Sanctioned)

(ONE FREE FUN RUN FOR YOUTH)

Can your canine find the hidden rat in the canister? Time starts when terrier is released. Judge "calls" time when quarry is located and marked. Class fee for runs for a 1-6 ribbon placement; sign up on entry form or at the Registration Desk. Youth fun runs must be AFTER official class.

Class 136: Puppies 6 up to 12 months

Class 137: Adults Class 138: Veterans

Class 139: Other Earthdog Puppy. Open to any other terrier or earthdog other than a JRT, aged 4-12 months.
