GENERAL ENTRY NOTES

FOR SAFETY REASONS - PLEASE DO NOT BRING YOUR TERRIERS TO THE REGISTRATION TABLE

- **Pre-Entry**: The pre-entry deadline in Trial Vault is Aug 4, 2024. The pre-entry postmark deadline is July 31, 2024. Entries received or paid after the deadline will be considered post entries. Pre-entry fees are \$12/class. Post entry fees are \$15/class. You are welcome to add classes, bump-ups, etc. during the trial!
- JRTCA Membership: You must be a current JRTCA member to participate in sanctioned classes. If your Jack Russell is registered or recorded with the JRTCA, the fee is \$2/day/dog. If your Jack Russell is not registered or recorded, the fee is \$7/day/dog. If you have an Other Terrier, these fees do not apply.
- Trial Vault: We are pleased to offer Trial Vault for entries and encourage you to use Trial Vault to make your online entries. The website is https://www.V3.trialvault.dog and there is no cost to create an account. If you prefer, you can fill out a manual entry form and send to the mailing address on the entry form. - **Payments:** Payments can be made through Stripe directly on TrialVault. Checks (payable to RMJRTN) can be mailed to Ellie Thompson 18405 Birdseye View Peyton Co 80831. Payment must be postmarked by August 1, 2024 for pre-entry rates.
- **Certificates:** A copy of your certificates must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries and/or available for ring steward. Certificates are required for Conformation Working classes, Go-to-Ground and Super Earth Championship Certificate classes
- Please travel with your health records for your terriers and have a signed rabies certificate and tag from your vet.
- All dogs must be leashed or crated or contained in an ex-pen except when competition requires off-leash work. Please, no flex leads.
- No grooming at ringside. Please limit grooming at the trial site. Grooming at hotels/motels is not permitted.
- Please pick up your trash, clean up after your dogs and leave the grounds as clean as you found them or better.
- All dogs MUST be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work
- Absolutely no puppies under 3 months of age are allowed on the grounds. Persons violating this rule will be asked to leave the trial grounds and will not receive a refund on any entry fees.
- Bitches in heat are NOT allowed on grounds Refunds provided with veterinary note
- Abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on trial grounds is strictly prohibited.
- No refunds will be given for missed classes. Please ask for assistance if you need it.
- Children (this includes participating Child Handlers) always require adult supervision while on the trial grounds.
- If you need to use marijuana for medical reasons, it must NOT be used at the Trial Site or Campgrounds.



TRIALING @ ELEVATION



Denver is almost 5,000 feet above sea level in town and up to 10,000 feet if you explore many of our surrounding mountain areas. PLEASE DRINK PLENTY OF WATER and USE SUNSREEN. It is easy to become dehydrated at our higher altitude. Don't overdue on physical activity. TAKE YOUR TIME, RELAX and ENJOY THE VIEWS, PLAY SAFELY, and LIMIT ALCOHOL CONSUMPTION. Colorado has marijuana laws and driving while impaired is a SERIOUS crime. Our local law enforcement are very good at their jobs, so please designate a driver for your party. Marijuana use in not allowed at the Elbert County Trial Site or Campgrounds.

Use caution when leaving your dogs in your cars, THE SUN IS VERY STRONG AT THIS ELEVATION. Please keep your dogs on a leash. It can be very tempting to let your dog pursue the wildlife and quarry including fox, badger, marmot, and raccoon that you may encounter in town and in the mountains. Colorado does have closed seasons, and unless you are on private property with permission of the landowner to work animals that may be a nuisance, it is illegal to chase quarry or enter dens with dogs this time of year.

GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10"-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division. Exception -Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1.
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of a nunder adult blich as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement of the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earthy must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. This rule also applies to RV's and campers if at the same address as the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site.
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Administrator.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website www.therealjackrussell.com
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. Judges must not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event.
- 24. THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS. All JRTCA rules must be followed.



Class 48: Child Handler

This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judges on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 49: Child Go To Ground

Open to any child ages 5-9 handling a JRT. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of G-T-G. Terrier to run through the 10-foot Novice liner, time NOT to be considered. (Non-sanctioned) Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 50: CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE - Non Sanctioned. Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner-up. Points earned in Child Handler & Child G-T-G each day

Class 51: Youth Handler

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling a Jack Russell Terrier. Judges on youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 52: Youth Working Judge's Choice

Open to any youth handler aged 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA working judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.

Class 53: Youth Go To Ground

Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-to-Ground. o be run through the 10-foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.

Class 54: YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE

Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up. Points earned in Youth Handler, Youth Working Judge's Choice & Youth G-T-G each day



CONFORMATION

DIVISION C: WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION

Section 1: JRTCA Working Terrier Conformation

Judged on JRTCA Breed Standard. Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. Terriers entering the Working Section may not cross-enter in the Open Section; no cross entering is permitted within the Working Section.

Class 55: Exhibition of the Working Jack Russell Terrier and Recognition

Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion and/or Lifetime Working Achievement. The class is intended as an exhibition of terriers that have earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field and/or their JRTCA Working Achievement Award. After the recognition parade, the Conformation Judge will do the honors of choosing a "Judge's Choice" terrier – the terrier they would take on a hunt. Non-sanctioned, no entry fee.

Class 56: Bronze Medallion Dog

Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 57: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Dog

Open to any Working Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 58: Working Terrier Dog, 10" up to 121/2"

Class 59: Working Terrier Dog, over 121/2" up to 15"

Class 60: Working Veteran Terrier Dog, 10" up to 121/2" six years and older

Class 61: Working Veteran Terrier Dog, over 121/2" up to 15" six years and older

Class 62: BEST WORKING TERRIER DOG & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Working Terrier Dog classes.

Class 63: Bronze Medallion Bitch

Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 64: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Bitch

Open to any Working Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 65: Working Terrier Bitch, 10" up to 121/2"

Class 66: Working Terrier Bitch, over 121/2" up to 15"

Class 67: Working Veteran Terrier Bitch, 10" up to 121/2" six years and older

Class 68: Working Veteran Terrier Bitch, over 121/2" up to 15" six years and older

Class 69: BEST WORKING TERRIER BITCH & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Working Terrier Bitch classes.

Class 70: WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE

Open to Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve and Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve.



PUPPY

Section 1: 3 up to 4 Month Puppy Conformation

Open to Jack Russell terriers and earthdogs. Designed to give your three- up to four-month-old puppies exposure to the conformation ring, this non-sanctioned class runs after the youth conformation classes and before regular conformation classes begin. Will be split by sex if entries warrant.

Class 71: 3 up to 4 Month Puppy - Non-Sanctioned

Section 2: 4 up to 6 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 72: Dog Pups, 4 up to 6 months

Class 73: Bitch Pups, 4 up to 6 months

Class 74: BEST 4 UP TO 6 MONTH PUPPY & RESERVE Open to the 1st and 2nd place winners of 4 up to 6-month Puppy Classes.

Section 3: 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 75: Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months

Class 76: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months

Class 77: BEST 6 UP TO 12 PUPPY DOG & RESERVE Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of 6–12-month puppy dog classes.

Class 78: Bitch Pups, 6 up to 9 months

Class 79: Bitch Pups, 9 up to 12 months

Class 80: BEST 6 UP TO 12 PUPPY BITCH & RESERVE Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of 6–12-month puppy bitch classes.

Class 81: PUPPY CONFORMATION CHAMPION & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Best Dog Puppy & Reserve and Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve.

DIVISION E: FAMILY

SECTION 1: FAMILY

Judged on the Breed Standard and consistency of type.

Class 82: Stud Dog and Get - *Must have at least two, but no more than three offspring at parent's side. Stud Dog must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.*

Class 83: Brood Bitch and Produce - *Must have at least two, but no more than three offspring at parent's side.* Brood bitch must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered.

Class 84: Working Family - Open to working stud dogs and working brood bitches with at least two, but no more than three adult working offspring at side. All terriers must have earned and received one or more JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificates.

Class 85: BEST FAMILY & RESERVE

Class 86: Three Generations

Open to a minimum of 3 successive generations of breeding; second and successive generations must be bred by Exhibitor. Judged on conformation and improvement.



DIVISION F: OPEN ADULT CONFORMATION

SECTION 1: OPEN ADULT CONFORMATION

Judged on JRTCA Breed Standard. No cross-entering is permitted within the Open Section. Terriers entering the Open Section may not cross-enter in the Working Section. Cross-entering is not permitted within the Open Section and Working Sections.

Class 87: Bred by Exhibitor Dog - Open to any Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 88: Dogs, 1 year and older 10" up to 121/2", smooth

Class 89: Dogs, 1 year and older 10" up to 121/2", rough/broken

Class 90: Dogs, 1 year and older over 121/2" up to 15", smooth

Class 91: Dogs, 1 year and older over 121/2" up to 15", rough/broken

Class 92: BEST OPEN DOG & RESERVE- Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Open Dog classes.

Class 93: Bred by Exhibitor Bitch - Open to any Jack Russell Terrier owned/ bred by the exhibitor under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 94: Bitches, 1 year and older 10" up to 121/2", smooth

Class 95: Bitches, 1 year and older 10" up to 121/2", rough/broken

Class 96: Bitches, 1 year and older over 121/2" up to 15", smooth

Class 97: Bitches, 1 year and older over 12½" up to 15", rough/broken

Class 98: BEST OPEN BITCH & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Open Bitch classes.

Class 99: BEST OPEN TERRIER & RESERVE

Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Best Dog & Reserve and Best Bitch & Reserve.

DIVISION G: MISCELLANEOUS CONFORMATION

SECTION 1: Other / Earthdog

Non-Sanctioned

Class 100: Other / Earthdog Puppy Non-Sanctioned

Class 101: Other / Earthdog Adult Non-Sanctioned

Class 102: OTHER / EARTHDOG BEST & RESERVE Non-Sanctioned



SECTION 2: Miscellaneous

Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier including those spayed and neutered. Those that are intact may enter the Miscellaneous Classes and may cross-enter into regular Conformation. Judged on breed standard and condition of the dog unless otherwise noted.

Class 103: Novice

Open to any adult Jack Russell which has never placed 1st through 4th in an adult regular or 1st in any Novice Conformation Class, at this or ANY prior sanctioned trial.

Class 104: Colorado Bred -

Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier bred in the State of Colorado.

Class 105: Matched Pairs -

Open to any 2 Jack Russell Terriers. Judged on conformation and matching appearance. Terriers do not have to be owned by the same person and may have one or two handlers in the ring.

Class 106: Spayed/Neutered Working Terrier

Open to any adult Spayed/Neutered Jack Russell Terrier, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate.

Class 107: Spayed/Neutered Adult Terrier

Open to any spayed/neutered JRT.

Class 108: Spayed/Neutered Veteran /Senior Terrier Open to spayed/neutered veteran or senior JRT.

Class 109: BEST SPAY/NEUTER TERRIER

Class 110: Veteran / Senior Terrier Open to Veteran/Senior JRTS

SECTION 3: Fun Conformation Ring Classes

Class 111: Costumes - Open to all breeds who loves to play "dress up". judged on costume originality and creativeness. Non-sanctioned. No entry fee.

Class 112: Tricks - Non-sanctioned. Open to all breeds. No entry fee. Judged on fun factor

SECTION 4: Suitability - Judge's Choice

Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier, including those which have been spayed/neutered. The dog the judge would choose to take hunting to each quarry listed below.

Class 113: Suitability to Red Fox

Class 114: Suitability to Groundhog

Class 115: Suitability to Raccoon/Badger



DIVISION H: GO-TO-GROUND

Go-To-Ground

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. For all classes: work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of the view of the judge. The judge may halt the work if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Copies of JRTCA trial certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging. Cross entering is not permitted between certificate classes. First and second place winners of the certificate classes will be Go-to-Ground Champion and Reserve.

<u>Directions</u>: Under each class, there will be a set amount of time to reach the quarry, how many times the terrier may leave & re-enter (if any), and how long the terrier must work the quarry, continuously (without a break) once reached. During work, the terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).

For GTG & Super Earth Divisions, once puppies/adults have moved up to the championship classes, they may not enter the open classes. Note: To keep Go-To-Ground moving efficiently, for those of you who have multiple terriers, please alternate with the other people in line. Thank you!

Class 116: Pre-Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 to 6 months of age. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 117: Novice Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another -- examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 118: Novice Adult

Open to JRTs 1 year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another -- examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 119: Open Puppy

Open to Jack Russells 6 to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy Go to Ground class at future trials. Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG. (01/22). (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work

and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another).

Class 120: Open Adult

Open to Jack Russells 1 year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another)

Class 121: Puppy Championship

Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and with-out leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another.)

Class 122: 10" up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12½", 1 year and older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

Class 123: Over 121/2" up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12½" up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry)

Class 124: 10" up to 121/2" Veteran Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 12 1/2", 6 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

Class 125: Over 121/2" up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell, 10" up to 121/2", 6 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

Class 125: 10" up to 121/2" Senior Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell, 9 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

Class 127: Over 121/2" up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate GTG

Open to any adult Jack Russell, 9 years of age or older, which holds a JRCTA trial certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. CROSS-ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN CERTIFICATE CLASSES. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry).

Class 128: Super Senior GTG 13 years or Older (Non-Sanctioned)

Open to any adult Jack Russell 13 years of age or older

Class 129: Other / Earthdog Novice / Puppy & Adult GTG

Non-Sanctioned. Open to Earth Dogs which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 130: Other / Earthdog Open Puppy / Adult

Non-Sanctioned. Open to Earthdogs which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work guarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving guarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

Class 131: Other / Earthdog Championship and Reserve GTG

Non-Sanctioned. Open to Earthdogs 6 months and over which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (30 seconds to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

DIVISION I: SUPER EARTH

Super Earth Go-to-Ground

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. Timing for all Super Earth classes: 1 second per total feet of tunnel; may leave and reenter the earth multiple times until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Classes may be combined as entries warrant. Sanctioned classes: check rules posted. Crossentering is not permitted between certificate classes.

Note: To keep Super Earth moving efficiently, for those of you who have multiple terriers, please alternate with the other people in line. Thank you!

Class 132: 6 up to 12-month Puppy OPEN Super Earth - Open to Jack Russell Terrier puppies, 6 up to 12 months. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth class at future trials. Open Puppy Super Earth is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth.

Class 133: 10" up to 12½" Adult OPEN Super Earth Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 134: Over 121/2" up to 15" Adult OPEN Super Earth Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 135: 10" up to 12½" Veteran OPEN Super Earth Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 136: Over 12¹/₂" up to 15" Veteran OPEN Super Earth Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 137: 6 up to 12-month Puppy Championship Super Earth

Open to 6 up to 12-month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12-month Super Earth Puppy class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% scoresheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to the den steward at the time of the class.



Class 138: 10" up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate Super Earth

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre- entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 139: Over 12½" up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate Super Earth

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre- entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 140: 10" up to 121/2" Veteran Championship Certificate Super Earth

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 141: Over 12½" up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate Super Earth

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 142: 10" up to 121/2" Senior Championship Certificate Super Earth

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 143: Over 121/2" up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate Super Earth

Open to Jack Russell Terriers, nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 144: Super Senior Super Earth 13 Years or Older - Ribbon

Non-Sanctioned. Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 13 years and older

Class 145: Other / Earthdog Super Earth, 6 months and older

Non-Sanctioned. Open to any Earth dog 6 mo. or older, who has scored 100% in this class at this trial or any previous trial. 30 seconds per 30 feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until quarry is reached then must work quarry for one minute, without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.

DIVISION J: FUN & FIELD

SECTION 1: Barn Hunt (Non-Sanctioned)

This timed event challenges the abilities of the canine and handler team to locate a live rat enclosed in a tube on a straw-bale course. Non-sanctioned.

Class 146: Puppy Barn Hunt

Open to JRTs, six months up to 12 months old. **Class 147: Adult Barn Hunt** Open to JRTs, one year up to six years old. **Class 148: Veteran Barn Hunt** Open to JRTs, six years up to nine years old. **Class 149: Senior Barn Hunt** Open to JRTs, nine years and older. **Class 150: Super Senior Barn Hunt**, 13 years and older **Class 151: Other / Earthdog Barn Hunt** - 6 months and older



SECTION 2: Urban Warfare (Non-Sanctioned)

Urban Warfare is an above-ground hunting simulation held in a fenced area. Quarry is hidden within the brush area. The challenge is for the terrier to use natural instincts to successfully locate and work the quarry. Terrier must work to find the quarry in the shortest amount of time. The clock starts when the judge is ready and signals you to release your dog at the gate. All four paws must be on the ground before you release your dog. The judge stops the clock when your dog has found the quarry. You do not enter with the dog but you can encourage your dog verbally. No hand signals allowed. The dog must locate the quarry to have a qualifying time. Non-Sanctioned

Class 152: Puppy Urban Warfare Class 153: Adult Urban Warfare Class 154: Veteran Urban Warfare Class 155: Senior Urban Warfare Class 156: Super Senior Urban Warfare, 13 years and older Class 157: Other / Earthdog Urban Warfare - 6 months and older Class 158: JUDGE'S CHOICE CHAMPION & RESERVE OF THE DAY JUDGES CHOICE



SECTION 3: Lure Coursing (Non-Sanctioned)

This is a timed event in which the terrier chases a lure in an enclosed fenced course. Each class entry will include 2 runs. All runs must be run back-to-back. Enter as many times as you like, however, only your best of two runs will be considered for ribbon placement. All other runs considered fun runs. (Non-Sanctioned Division).




