- Class conflicts may occur. Please schedule carefully. No refunds for missed classes. Refunds for classes will be given only in case of accident or illness to a terrier or owner, or for bitches in heat.
- ✤ Dogs must be leashed or crated at all times.
- No puppies under three months of age permitted on the grounds.
- ✤ No puppy sales are permitted on the trial site.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated at any time during the trial. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship will be dismissed from the grounds.
- Provide all certificates for those classes for which they are required
- ✤ JRTCA rulebook can be downloaded at www.therealjackrussell.com
- ♦ A COPY OF JRTCA MEMBERSHIP CERTIFICATE MUST BE PRESENTED

Important Notice:

Every effort was made to schedule classes so you may enter as many events as possible. It is your responsibility to be aware of scheduled classes, in each division, and to be on time for every class. The Committee will not be responsible for conflicts that may occur, and classes WILL NOT be held up due to conflicts between events. Please review the class list and agenda and plan your classes accordingly!

* The \$7.00 JRTCA fee for non-registered/recorded terriers will not be charged to those entering only non-sanctioned classes, nor to those first joining the JRTCA at the trial.

Directions to Trial Site:

From I-40: Take Exit#16South(GermantownRd.) Continue on Germantown Road for 8 miles until it narrows to 2 lanes at Poplar Pike (traffic light). Turn left on Poplar Pike and the show grounds will be approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile on the right.

From I-240: Exit Poplar Avenue East to Germantown Road (BP Station on South Corner). Turn right on Germantown Road, then left on Poplar Pike (traffic light). The show grounds will be approximately¹/₄ mile on the right. Directions are also on Google maps.

GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified, and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10 15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed / neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
- 9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division. (Exception Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1)
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier Classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the ring/den steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC certificate signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's and campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds) (01/22)
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event.
- 24. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!

NOTE: No sale of Puppies at the trial site. No underage puppies on the trial grounds, including the camping area.

Jacks R Wild! Poker ** Pre-entry Only** \$10 entry fee per dog Saturday only Enter in Trial Vault or enter class 195 on the manual entry form

You can enter as many dogs as you like. Each dog will have their own poker hand. Participating dogs will receive a playing card for each class in which they are entered, including Sunday classes. You need at least 2 cards per dog. NOT TO EXCEED 5 PLAYING CARDS PER DOG!

The dog with the best hand is the Winner!! Don't forget....Jacks R Wild!!

If you enter multiple dogs, you cannot combine cards to improve your poker hand. Cards will be issued for paid classes only. You will not get additional cards if your dog is moved to a championship class.

If your dog is not entered in five classes and you would like to get additional cards, you can pay for additional runs at See Jack Run, Lure Coursing or Barn Hunt to receive another card or you can play fewer than 5 cards. Cards will be issued at the trial office.

To play, you must pre-enter a dog in the class for this event.

Players must draw and report your poker hand, at the time of drawing, to the office by 3:00pm Saturday. At the end of the day **Saturday**, we will have a winner, after ribbons are handed out. 50% of the proceeds will go to the winners: 70% to a "Champion" and 30% to a "Reserve Champion".

RACING

RULES:

- All terriers, including 4-6 month puppies, must be muzzled!
- Plastic muzzle or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No Baskerville muzzles, figure eight or open-ended muzzles will be allowed. Colored basket and colored softie muzzles are not allowed. Black, brown, clear, or white muzzles are acceptable.
- Any entry going around the jumps, jumping out of the racetrack or not wearing a secured muzzle will be disqualified from that race and, therefore, shown as not finishing that race.
- All requests for height measurement must be made by 7:45 AM to the racing judge. Terriers will be measured with approved JRTCA wickets.
- Qualifications for Championships Runoffs: Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle final to qualify for championship run offs. A terrier MUST ENTER AND FINISH in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final). A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final championship race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in the final. A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.
- Adult terriers may not cross-enter between Adult, Veteran and Senior Racing Classes.

Racing Course Set-up: 300-foot track; up to 14-inch-high foam jumps; foam catch barrier; "Joe Bag" as the back stop; 30 foot catch pen with trained, experienced catchers. Designed for the safety of our terriers, our goal.

Exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handling and Youth Go-to-Ground to qualify for the Youth High Score & Reserve. In case of a tie, it will be broken by a handling class to be held in the Conformation Ring; Judge to be decided by the Trial Chairperson.

CONFORMATION

RULES:

- Cross entering is not permitted within or between the Open and Working Sections.
- Exhibitors participating in the working Classes must submit the appropriate JRTCA Paperwork with entries. The judge may require a copy of the Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC) to be presented to the ring steward at the time of judging.
- Spayed or neutered terriers may only compete in Miscellaneous Conformation classes.
- Child / Youth Conformation will start first.

- Class 58: Best & Reserve Pups, 3 up to 4 months. May be split by sex if entries warrant.
 - 1st place pup is Best and 2nd place pup is Reserve, ribbons awarded for 3rd-6th placements. (Non-Sanctioned)
- Class 59: Dog pups, 4 up to 6 months
- Class 60: Bitch pups, 4 up to 6 months
- Class 61: Best 4 up to 6 Month Puppy & Reserve. Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 59 & 60. No entry fee.

6 up to 12 MONTH PUPPY CONFORMATION

- Class 62: Dog Pups, 6 up to 9 months
- Class 63: Dog Pups, 9 up to 12 months
- Class 64: <u>Best 6 up to 12 Month Dog Pup & Reserve.</u> Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 62 & 63. No entry fee.

JRTCA WORKING TERRIER CONFORMATION

- Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. Please submit copy of the NHC with entries.
- Terriers entering the Working Section may NOT cross-enter into the Open Section; no cross entering is permitted within the Working Section.
- Classes may be combined by height and coat type at the Trial Chairperson's discretion.
- Class 69: Bronze Medallion Dog: Open to any dog that has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.
- Class 70: Bred by Exhibitor Working Terrier Dog: Open to any Working Jack Russell Terrier owned and bred by the exhibitor *under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered*; must be handled by the breeder or a member of the breeder's immediate family.
- Class 71: Working Terrier Dog, 10" up to 12¹/₂"
- Class 72: Working Terrier Dog, over 12¹/₂" up to 15"
- Class 73: Veteran Working Terrier Dog: Open to any Working JRT six years or older

Class 104: <u>Pre-Novice Puppy.</u> Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Novice Puppy & Novice Adult - One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

- Class 105: <u>Novice Puppy.</u> Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial.
- Class 106: <u>Novice Adult</u>. Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial.

Open Puppy & Open Adult - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; must work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

- Class 107: <u>Open Puppy</u>. Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Not open to any puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.) Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship GTG they cannot return to Open.

- Class 119: Other Earthdog Championship and Reserve GTG: Open to any Earthdog, up to 15", 6 months & older who has scored 100% in the Open class at ANY previous trial, 1st & 2nd place winners are the Champion & Reserve. (One second per foot to reach quarry; may not leave earth; work quarry for one full minute, without a break in work & without leaving the quarry. Puppies may leave and re-enter the earth once.)

SUPER EARTH

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and reenter several times until the quarry is reached then must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

<u>Rules</u>: no prior schooling; only the dog is allowed in the fenced area; dog owner may give verbal commands only; the clock starts the moment the dog is released. CROSS ENTERING IS NOT PERMITTED BETWEEN Super Earth Classes.

- Class 120: <u>6 up to 12 month Open Puppy Super Earth</u>. Puppies receiving a 100% score in this Class at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee enter the Puppy Championship class at this trial OR may continue competing in the Open Puppy SE Class at future trials. Open Puppy Super Earth Class is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth.
- Class 121: <u>10" up to 12 ½" Open Adult Super Earth</u>. Open to terriers one year and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 122: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Open Adult Super Earth. Open to terriers one year and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 123: <u>10" up to 12 ½" Open Veteran Super Earth</u>. Open to terriers six years and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 124: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Open Veteran Super Earth. Open to terriers six years and older. May continue to compete in Open Adult class until they apply for and receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the open adult class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA.
- Class 125: <u>6 up to 12-month Puppy Champion Super Earth</u>. Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 month Puppy Super Earth Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to den steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve. Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship SE they cannot return to Open Puppy Super Earth.

NOSE WORK

Saturday Only

Sanctioned event, open to JRT six months and older who are capable of alerting to the target odors. Level 1 target odor is birch. Level 2 target odors are birch, anise and clove. A Level 1 title is not required to enter Level 2 classes. Time faults incurred for dropped food, failure to go through start-line marker, excessive disturbance of search area, incorrect call in Level 1 and failure to call finish in Level 2 searches. Eliminating (pee, poop or vomit) in a search area ends the search and results in a non-qualifying score and no placement. Consult the rulebook for more detailed information. First through sixth ribbons for each class determined by correct calls with fastest time first. Champion and reserve champion ribbons awarded to top two JRTs in Level 1 and top two JRTs in Level 2 by combining scores for all elements/classes. Teams with no faults considered first.

- Class 140: JRT Beginner Sniffer: Open to dogs who have not shown in any other nose work venue. Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers (same as Level 1) placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart with 1 birch hide. Two minute time limit. One incorrect call is allowed. Placement ribbons only. Not eligible for the championship.
- Class 141: JRT Level 1 Container Search: Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart with 1 birch hide and a 2-minute time limit. Can be set up in 1 straight line or 2 straight rows. Teams must go through start-line markers and call "alert" when hide is found. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.
- Class 142: JRT Level 1 Exterior Search: Search area will be between 100 and 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Hide will be no higher than 12 inches and will not be buried in the ground. Teams must go through start-line markers and call "alert" when hide is found. Time limit is two minutes. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.
- Class 143: JRT Level 2 Container Search: Consists of 10 to 14 containers spaced at least 2 feet apart in any configuration. Can be any type of container that is not transparent. Containers do not have to be identical and can be elevated up to 24 inches. There are 2 hides. Can be birch, anise, or clove. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call "alert" when hides are found and "finish" after the second hide is found. Incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Time limit is 2:30 minutes.
- Class 144: JRT Level 2 Exterior Search: Search area will be at least 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Hides are placed no higher than 24 inches and will not be buried in the ground. There are two hides. Can be birch, anise or clove. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call "alert" when hides are found and "finish" after the second hide is found. An incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Search time between 2:30 minutes and 4 minutes is determined by the judge.
- Class 145: JRT Level 1 Nose Work Champion & Reserve To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 1 classes offered. At this trial, the scores for the Level 1 Container class and Level 1 Exterior classes are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons are awarded to the top two dogs. No entry Fee.
- Class 146: JRT Level 2 Nose Work Champion & Reserve To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 2 classes offered. At this trial, the scores for the Level 2 Container class and Level 2 Exterior classes are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons are awarded to the top two dogs. No Entry Fee.

EARTHDOG NOSE WORK (Non-Sanctioned). Open to earthdogs capable of alerting to target odors of birch, anise and clove. Same rules as JRT Nose Work classes. May enter both Level 1 and Level 2 classes.

- Class 147: Earthdog Level 1 Container Search: Eight to 10 identical containers placed on the floor and spaced at least two feet apart with one birch hide and a two-minute time limit. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.
- Class 148: Earthdog Level 1 Exterior Search: Clearly marked search area will be between 100 and 200 square feet. Hide no higher than 12 inches and not buried in the ground. Teams must go through start-line markers and call "alert" when hide is found. Time limit is two minutes. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.
- Class 149: Earthdog Level 2 Container Search: Consists of 10 to 14 containers of any type spaced at least two feet apart in any configuration. Do not have to be identical and can be elevated up to 24 inches. There are two hides-birch, anise or clove. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call "alert" when hides are found and "finish" after the second hide is found. An incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Time limit is 2:30 minutes.
- Class 150: Earthdog Level 2 Exterior Search: Clearly marked search area will be at least 200 square feet. Hides are placed no higher than 24 inches and will not be buried in the ground. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call "alert" when hides are found and "finish" after the second hide is found. Incorrect call ends the search and results in a non- qualifying run. Search time between 2:30 minutes and 4 minutes is determined by the judge.
- Class 151: Earthdog Level 1 Nose Work Champion & Reserve To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 1 classes offered. At this trial, the scores for the Level 1 Container class and Level 1 Exterior classes are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons are awarded to the top two dogs. No entry fee.
- Class 152: Earthdog Level 2 Nose Work Champion & Reserve To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 2 classes offered. At this trial, the scores for the Level 2 Container class and Level 2 Exterior classes are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion and Reserve Champion ribbons are awarded to the top two dogs. No entry fee.

MISCELLANEOUS DOG NOSE WORK (Non-Sanctioned). Open to ANY DOG capable of alerting to target odors of birch, anise and clove. Same rules as JRT Nose Work classes. May enter both Level 1 and Level 2 classes. (SEE DESCRIPTION ABOVE)

- Class 153: Misc. Dog: Open to dogs who have not shown in any other nose work venue. Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers (same as Level 1) placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart with 1 birch hide. Two minute time limit. One incorrect call is allowed. Placement ribbons only. Not eligible for the championship.
- Class 154: Container Search Level 1: Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart with 1 birch hide and a 2-minute time limit. Can be set up in 1 straight line or 2 straight rows. Teams must go through start-line markers and call "alert" when hide is found. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.
- Class 155: Exterior Search Level 1: Search area will be between 100 and 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Hide will be no higher than 12 inches and will not be buried in the ground. Teams must go through start-line markers and call "alert" when hide is found. Time limit is two minutes. One incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault.
- Class 156: Container Search Level 2: Consists of 10 to 14 containers spaced at least 2 feet apart in any configuration. Can be any type of container that is not transparent. Containers do not have to be identical and can be elevated up to 24 inches. There are 2 hides. Can be birch, anise, or clove. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call "alert" when hides are found and "finish" after the second hide is found. Incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Time limit is 2:30 minutes.
- Class 157: Exterior Search Level 2: Search area will be at least 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Hides are placed no higher than 24 inches and will not be buried in the ground. There are two hides. Can be birch, anise or clove. Teams must go through start-line markers. Handlers must call "alert" when hides are found and "finish" after the second hide is found. An incorrect call ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Search time between 2:30 minutes and 4 minutes is determined by the judge.

NON-SANCTIONED EVENTS

BARN HUNT (Non-Sanctioned)

This timed event challenges the abilities of the canine to locate a live rat enclosed in one or more tubes on a straw bale course. <u>Judge calls time</u>. **Perpetual Trophy: Weekend Barn Hunt Champion** (*Two-day combined fastest time*).
