Prior to receiving Club benefits the application & payment must be received. <u>Club memberships cannot be made through Trial Vault.</u>

Entries: Entries must be received on or before **August 9**th to be considered a pre-entry. Entries received or paid **after** August 9th are considered post-entries and may not be able to race. GTG & S/E move-ups are at your original entry fee. Pre-entry fees per class are: MWJRTC Members \$ 14.00 & Non-Members \$ 16.00. The post-entry fee for everyone is \$ 17.00 per class. **No post-entries for racing, unless heats are not full and the post-entry is approved by the Trial Office.**

Trial Vault: We accept online registrations through the Trial Vault system. To access Trial Vault, go to <u>https://v3.trialvault.dog/</u>. If you prefer not to pre-register for classes, we urge you to create a free account with Trial Vault by the August 9th pre-registration deadline so your information can be accessed if you come to the trial. There is a \$ 25.00 fee if we must set up your account for you during the trial. If you need help creating a Trial Vault account or registering for the trial, **please contact Jill Olson at** <u>trialsecretary@mwjrtc.com</u>.

Payment: Pay by check & save the Credit Card/PayPal convenience processing fees!

Pre-entries are not considered complete until payment is received on or before August 9th. Mail your check or money order, payable to MWJRTC, to Jill Olson, MWJRTC Treasurer, 745 Vavricka Rd., Montfort, WI 53569. Checks mailed must be **received on or before Aug. 9th**. All check or money order payments must be in U.S. dollars. There is a \$40.00 fee for returned checks. Exhibitors will be responsible for the "Convenience Fees" charged by PayPal or Stripe credit card payments. Credit Card payments made through Trial Vault will automatically have the Stripe convenience fee added to their invoice for payment. If paying separately with PayPal please add 3% for the convenience fees to your payment or pay the fees when you pick up your entry packet at the trial. Send PayPal payments to Midwest Jack Russell Terrier Club Inc.

Refund Policy: Credit card payments will be refunded minus any processing fees charged to us by Stripe & PayPal. If paid by check, uncashed checks will be shredded or returned. If checks were cashed, refund checks will be mailed after the trial. For prepaid entry fees, 100% minus fees will be refunded for entries withdrawn on or before August 9th. 100% minus fees will be refunded for bitches in heat when presented with a veterinary certificate dated on or after August 9th that certifies the bitch entered was in heat. 50% minus fees will be refunded for entries withdrawn after August 9th but before August 16. NO REFUND will be issued for no-shows or cancellations received on or after August 16.

Championship Certificate Classes: Copies of the certificates must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries, or shown to the Trial Secretary or Den Stewards at the trial. For Working Conformation classes, a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate is required. To qualify for Go-T0-Ground and Super Earth Championship Certificate classes, your terrier must have the corresponding certificates. For more information about obtaining certificates, see the JRTCA web site link, <u>https://www.therealjackrussell.com/breed/certificates.php</u>.

High Score & Reserve for Youth Handler & Child Handler. Ribbons for Bronze Medallion Celebration. Ribbons & Awards for High-Point Versatility. First – Sixth place Ribbons for all classes.

Earthdog Classes & Awards: We offer classes for earthdogs in all events. Earthdog classes are open to Terriers and other earthdog breeds such as dachshunds that measure no more than 15 inches tall at the withers. The earthdog classes are not open to JRT's registered or recorded with the JRTCA. Ribbon & Awards for the High-Point Versatility. First – Sixth place Ribbons for all other classes. All Earthdog classes are non-sanctioned.

Other Breeds - Classes are offered at this trial for Other Breeds in the following divisions: Agility, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt, Lure Coursing, Nose Work, Trail/Locating, Friday Stakes Barn Hunt & Friday Brush Hunt Challenge.

Jack Russell Terrier High-Point Versatility Awards: These 2 non-sanctioned awards highlight the versatility of our JRT Puppies & Adults (1 year & Older). To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in Trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices. Points are accumulated each day for the ribbons-awards, which are presented at the end of each day. For details on how to earn points, see page 25.

Earthdog High-Point Versatility Award: This non-sanctioned award highlights the versatility of our Earthdogs. To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in Trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices. Points are accumulated each day for the Ribbon & Award, which will be presented at the end of each day. For details on how to earn points, see page 25.

Food: The food truck "That's My Dawg" will be at the trial site on Saturday and Sunday.

Conformation Ringside Parking: Reserve spaces in Trial Vault in the "Add-on" section along with your entries. Spaces are approximately 10 x 10 feet. Spaces assigned on a first come, first served basis with preference given to 2-day reservations. Cost is \$ 20.00 for 2 days (Saturday & Sunday) or \$ 15.00 per day (if available). Please let us know if you want to be located near another exhibitor by adding a note in the "Add-On" section of Trial Vault. If possible, we will comply to your request. Reservations will be confirmed.

Camping: This year, all reservations are made through Trial Vault in the "Add-on" section, no need to fill out a separate form. When reserving a campsite, help us improve your stay be providing your vehicle type, preferred location electrical hookup and water needs. We honor requests in the order received. Assignments are made the Sunday before the Summer Celebration trial and will be sent to the email provided with your entries. Your trial packet may include a permit to display on your windshield. The charge for RV camping is \$ 45.00 per night or \$ 90.00 for the trial weekend (Thursday p.m. through Monday a.m.). The tent and overnight vehicle parking charge is \$ 25.00 per night. Your stay includes access to shower/toilet facilities 24/7 as well as waste & trash disposal. Please pay camping fees with your Trial Vault entry.

See the fairgrounds map on page 27. In the far northeast corner of the fairground's property is the "Outback", a large RV park with water, 30-amp electrical access. Rough Camping spaces with 20-amp service & water is abundant. For sites outside of the Outback, we recommend you have UL-certified electrical service adaptors, 100 feet of UL-Certified electrical service cord & 100 feet of potable water hose. No camping in conformation ringside spaces.

Vendors: Vendors are welcome. We ask that vendors donate an item to the raffle and notify <u>trialchair@mwjrtc.com</u> so we can designate a space for the booths. Please plan to visit their booths in the pavilion.

Raffle: Ticket sales end at 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. The drawing takes place at 5:15 p.m. (estimated time) in the main pavilion. Tickets are drawn and the winning tickets attached to prizes. You need not be present during the drawing, but you must be able to take prizes with you or have a friend pick them up. Donate a raffle item and get 10 free tickets. Tickets can be pre-purchased in bundles of 30 or 170 in the "Add On" section of Trial Vault along with your entries. Tickets may also be purchased at the Trial Office or from the Raffle Masters during the Trial.





PUPPIES under the age of 3 months and bitches in season are NOT permitted on the trial grounds: Any person violating this JRTCA rule will be excused from all classes and asked to leave the trial site. This includes the camping area, RVs and vehicles on the trial site. There will be no refunds, and we are required to document violations. Violators may be subject to additional penalties

JRTCA Administration Fees & Membership: You must be a JRTCA member if you are planning on entering your JRT's in any "sanctioned" classes. Your JRT's do not have to be registered or recorded with the JRTCA to attend a sanctioned trial. Adult JRT's who are registered or recorded and puppies not yet eligible for registration or recording pay a JRTCA administration fee of \$ 2.00 per dog per day if the JRT is entered in any "sanctioned" classes. The JRTCA Administration fee for JRT's who are not registered or recorded is \$ 7.00 per dog per day if the JRT is entered in any "sanctioned classes". JRTCA Applications forms will also be available during the Trial in the Trial Office.

JRTCA Sanctioned Trial 2025 Rulebook: There have been some changes to rules for Racing, GTG Super Earth & Nosework. See the racing information in the class list. For some GTG and Super Earth classes, the times to reach quarry are now based on the length of the tunnel. Copies of the rulebook will be available at the trial. General Rules For All Exhibitors

- 1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- 2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be members of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified, and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they entered.
- 3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
- 4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
- 5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
- 6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family*, Open or Working Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
- 7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under the Judge in the conformation division.
- 8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child or Youth Handling.
- 9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division or section which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division.
- 10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terries.
- 11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for measurement of a terrier in the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult dog entered in the Championship Races). Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.
- 12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
- 13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate GTG and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
- 14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's & campers if at the same address as the trial grounds).
- 15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
- 16. Overly aggressive dogs or an owner's failure to control their dogs, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
- 17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
- 18. Dogs, other than JRT's on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
- 19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
- 20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be downloaded for the JRTCA website <u>www.therealjackrussell.com</u>
- 21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
- 22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
- 23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event.
- 24. The Judge's decision is final in all Divisions.

Youth Division

No entry Fee. The sanctioned Youth Division is open to JRTCA child and/or youth members in the following age brackets: Child Handler (ages 5 thru 9) and Youth Handler (ages 10 thru 16). A child/youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the current calendar year except for those children turning 5 years of age. They may begin competing in Child Handler any time following their fifth birthday. All exhibitors in the Youth Division must be current JRTCA members, either under a Family membership or under an individual Youth membership. Youths or their families applying for a JRTCA membership at a Sanctioned Trial will be allowed to enter classes at that trial. Youth exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handler and Youth Go To Ground to qualify for the Youth High Score & Reserve. Child exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Child Handler and Child Go To Ground to qualify for the Child High Score & Reserve (non-sanctioned). A tie will be broken with the final decision made by a conformation Judge other than the judge of the day. The tiebreaker takes place in the conformation ring and is determined at the Judge's discretion by the exhibitor's handling/presentation of his/her terrier, by the answers to the judge's questions, or by a combination of the two. Note: If there is no other available conformation judge on the grounds, then the judge of the day will determine the tiebreaker. - Class 52 : **Child Handler,** Open to any child ages 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months or older. Judged on child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.
- Class 53 : **Youth Handler**, Open to any youth ages 10 through 16, handling an Adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog & knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.
- Class 54 : **Youth Go To Ground,** Open to any youth ages 10 through 16, handling an Adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go To Ground. To be run through the 10-foot novice liner; time not to be considered. Terriers competing in Youth GTG, if entered in regular GTG classes, must compete in the regular GTG class prior to competing in the Youth GTG class.
- Class 55: **Child Go To Ground,** (Non-sanctioned) Open to any child ages 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months or older. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go To Ground. To be run through the 10-foot liner; time not to be considered. Terriers competing in Child GTG, if entered in regular GTG classes, must compete in the regular GTG class prior to competing in the Child GTG class.
- Class 56 : **Youth Off/On Lead Agility,** Open to any youth ages 10 through 16 handling an Adult Jack Russell Terrier. May choose to participate off or on lead. The Youth class will be two parts: Part one will be a mini seminar with all participants. The Youth will then demonstrate their knowledge gained in the mini seminar. Part two will be a demonstration team running a short course with evaluation by the Youth in a one-on-one discussion with the judge.
- Class 57 : **Youth Handler High Score & Reserve.** Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runnerup in Youth Handler, Youth GTG and Youth Agility classes. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 points; and participation = 1 point.
- Class 58 : **Child Handler High Score & Reserve.** (Non-sanctioned) Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in Child Handler and Child GTG classes. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th = 3 points; 6th = 2 points; and participation = 1 point.

Racing Division

Judge's Briefing at 8:15 a.m. Adult terriers may not cross-enter between regular racing classes, veteran racing classes & senior racing classes. Terriers must be muzzled for racing! Plastic muzzles or close-ended cloth muzzles only. Black, brown, clear or white muzzles are acceptable; no colored basket or softie muzzles are allowed. No figure 8 or open-ended or Baskerville open-ended muzzles will be allowed.

Racing Note for Championship Run Off:

- A. Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle race final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the backside of the barrier.
- B. A terrier MUST ENTER & FINISH in both, at least one flat & 1 hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final).
- C. A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final championship race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in the final.
- D. A FINISHED race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier.
- E. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.

Schooling prior to the competition is NOT permitted (any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from GTG at this trial). For all GTG classes: Terriers may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare to digging to baying). Work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing work for a period of more than 10 seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from quarry and out of view of the judge. The judge may halt the work is the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Class 96 : Pre-Novice JRT Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies, 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter until quarry is reached; work quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work & without leaving quarry.

Class 97: Novice JRT Puppy

Open to Jack Russell puppies, 6 up to 12 months, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA Trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work & without leaving the quarry.

Class 98: Novice JRT Adult

Open to Jack Russells, 1 year & Older, which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Adult class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work & without leaving the quarry.

Class 99: Open JRT Puppy

Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months, which have scored 100% in a Novice GTG class at this trial or previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG Class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy GTG class at future trials. Open Puppy GTG is NOT open to any puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter **once** until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work & without leaving quarry.

Class 100 : Open JRT Adult

Open to Jack Russells, 1 year & Older, which have scored 100% in a Novice GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Terriers which score 100% in the Open Adult class, are eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when the terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter **once** until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work & without leaving quarry.

Class 101 : JRT Puppy Championship

Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months, which have earned 100% in an Open GTG class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open Score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Puppy GTG Champion & Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once & re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

For ALL Champion Certificate GTG classes listed below: A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry (preferred - enter in Trial Vault) or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. Cross-entering is NOT permitted between Certificate Classes.

Class 102 : 10" up to 12 1/2" Adult JRT Championship Certificate

Open to Jack Russells, 1 year up to 6 years, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Adult GTG Champion & Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 104 : **10" up to 12** ½" **Veteran JRT Championship Certificate** Open to Jack Russells, 6 years & Older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Under Veteran GTG Champion & Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 105 : Over 12 ¹/₂" up to 15" Veteran JRT Champion Certificate

Open to Jack Russells, 6 years & Older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Veteran GTG Champion & Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 106 : **10" up to 12** ½" **Senior JRT Championship Certifi**cate Open to Jack Russells, 9 years & Older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Under Senior GTG Champion & Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 107 : **Over 12** ½" **up to 15**" **Senior JRT Champion Certificate** Open to Jack Russells, 9 years & Older, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Senior GTG Champion & Reserve. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.


Earthdog GTG - Height is limited to Earthdogs 15" and under. (Non-sanctioned)

Class 108 : Earthdog Novice

Open to Earthdogs, up to 15" tall, 6 months & Older, who have not scored 100% in a Earthdog Novice GTG at previous trials. Entries earning 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Earthdog Open class at this trial. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 109 : Earthdog Open

Open to Earthdogs, up to 15" tall, 6 months & Older, who have scored 100% in a Earthdog Novice class at this or previous trials. One second per total feet of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth & re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.



Super Earth Division

A more challenging GTG tunnel is used for this Super Earth course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Terriers, 6 months & Older. Schooling prior to the competition is NOT permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification from Super Earth competition at this trial. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated state or digging to baying)..

For ALL Champion Certificate Super Earth classes listed below: A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry (preferred - enter in Trial Vault) or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. Cross-entering is NOT permitted between Certificate Classes.

Timing Super Earth Classes: One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter the earth multiple times until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work & without leaving quarry. Terrier is Not to leave quarry once it is reached. For more information about Super Earth, go to: <u>https://www.therealjackrussell.com</u> under Trial – click on Super Earth.

- Class 110 : **6 up to 12 months, Open JRT Puppy Super Earth**. Open to Jack Russell Terrier puppies, 6 up to 12 months. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial or may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth at future trials. Open Puppy Super Earth is Not open to any puppy that has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth previously.
- Class 111 : **10" up to 12 ½", Open Adult JRT Super Earth**. Open to terriers 1 year & older.
- Class 112: Over 12 ¹/₂" up to 15", Open Adult JRT Super Earth. Open to terriers 1 year & older.
- Class 113 : **6 up to 12 month, JRT Puppy Champion Super Earth.** Open to Jack Russell Terrier puppies, 6 up to 12 months, which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 month Puppy Super Earth class at this trial or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% scoresheet must be presented with pre-entry or be shown to the den steward at the time of the class. 1st & 2nd place winners will be the Puppy Super Earth Champion & Reserve.
- Class 114 : **Adult JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, 10" up to 12 1/2".** Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 1 year & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Under Adult Super Earth Champion & Reserve.
- Class 115 : Adult JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, over 12 ¹/₂" up to 15". Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 1 year & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Over Adult Super Earth Champion & Reserve.
- Class 116 : **Veteran JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, 10" up to 12 1/2".** Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 6 years & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be Under Veteran Super Earth Champion & Reserve.
- Class 117 : **Veteran JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, over 12** ¹/₂" **up to 15**". Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 6 years & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be the Over Veteran Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

- Class 118 : **Senior JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, 10" up to 12 ½".** Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 9 years & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be the Under Senior Super Earth Champion & Reserve.
- Class 119 : **Senior JRT Champion Certificate Super Earth, Over 12** ½" **up to 15**". Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 9 years & older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. 1st & 2nd place winners will be the Over Senior Super Earth Champion & Reserve.

Earthdog Super Earth - Height is limited to Earthdogs 15" and under. (Non-sanctioned) Class 120 : Earthdog Super Earth, 15" & under, 6 months & Older

Saturday & Sunday

Trailing & Locating Division

Trailing & Locating is a sanctioned event that involves the terrier tracking and locating a quarry above ground. The terrier is judged on its ability to follow a line in a simulated natural hunting environment, to locate, mark & open on the quarry. <u>The terrier is judged on a combination of time & accuracy</u>. The terrier with the fastest time is not necessarily the winner. Course length is a minimum of 50 steps long with at least 2 direction changes but no more than 4 direction changes. No cross-entering between classes.

- Class 121: JRT Puppies, Open to Jack Russell Terrier Puppies, 6 up to 12 months
- Class 122: **JRT Adults**, Open to Adult Jack Russel Terriers, 1 year & older
- Class 123: JRT Veteran, Open to Veteran Jack Russell Terriers, 6 years & older
- Class 124 : **JRT Senior**, Open to Senior Jack Russell Terriers, 9 years & older

Class: 125 : **JRT Trailing & Locating Champion & Reserve**. Champion & Reserve Champion ribbons & awards to the <u>2 best scores</u> from above JRT trailing & locating classes. No entry fee.

Earthdog & Miscellaneous Trailing & Locating

Class 126 : **Earthdogs**, 6 months & older

Class 127: **Other Breeds,** Open to all breeds, 6 months & older, other than JRT's & Earthdogs.

(Non-sanctioned)

Agility Division

All terriers must be at least 1 year old of age to compete in JRTCA Agility or practice on any equipment. Dogs may run naked or wear one flat collar without tags. No other accoutrements are allowed. No food or toys are allowed within 10 feet of ring. Exceptions are that toys are allowed for the class "A Way To Play". A Beginner Agility certificate may be earned prior to competing in Advanced Agility & for Agility High Score Champion & Reserve. Move ups from Beginner Agility to Advance Agility are allowed from Trial to Trial. (Example: 2nd Beginner leg is earned at Saturday's trial; the team could move to Advanced Agility for Sunday's trial). As a JRTCA certificate has not been issued, both qualifying score sheets must be presented to move up. Advanced Agility competitors may cross enter the Beginner Agility class for Exhibit Only (FEO) to be used as a warmup run. No ribbon will be rewarded, and no paperwork completed for an FEO run. Teams with two scores of 190 or greater in the Agility classes (Beginner and Advance) are eligible for agility certificates. Teams with one qualifying score of 200 in Jumpers are eligible for the Jumpers certificate. For a complete set of rules, go to: <u>https://therealjackrussell.com</u> under Trial – click on Agility.

Jump Heights – The Under category will jump 8", the Over category will jump 12" as an Adult & owner's decision of 8" or 12" as a Veteran. Seniors will jump 4" regardless of height of the terrier.

Note: Sat & Sun Obstacle Familiarization: **\$5 per run, sign up for these runs on the Add-On Section of Trial Vault or on the entry form.** Can make multiple runs as time & number of entries allowed.

Class 128 : **JRT A Way to Play.** For the true beginner looking for experience in the ring, though this class can be used to explore a new experience with your partner. Class is judged based on performance of the obstacles on the field and points are earned for successfully completed obstacles: jumps are 1 point, tunnels are 3 points,

contacts/combinations are 5 points. Toys/Lures are allowed & coaching by experienced competitors and the judge is encouraged. No food is allowed. Teams have 60 seconds to accumulate points. Can be cross entered with Beginner Agility. Non-certificate class.

Class 129 : **JRT Beginner Agility.** 1.75 yd/sec, 11-14 obstacles. Complete at least 1 contact, minimum of 2 tunnels & single bar jumps.

Class 130: **JRT Advance Agility.** 2.25 yd/sec, 15-18 obstacles. Must complete at least 2 up to 3 contact obstacles. Can be either same obstacle or different ones. Must complete either 1 set of 12 weaves OR 2 sets of 6 weaves. Must complete at least 1 spread jump (double, triple, broad, or wall). Must complete 2-3 tunnels.

Class 131: **JRT Jumpers.** 2 yd/sec, 15-18 obstacles. Single bar jumps, with or without wings, is acceptable. Minimum of 1 up to 3 spread jumps. Maximum of 3 tunnels.

Class 132 : **JRT Full House (Point Accumulation Game).** This is a time management game which requires the team to reach the finish obstacle prior to 40 seconds. For every second over 40 seconds, the team will lose 1 point. A qualifying score is 25 points or above within the time limit. Each obstacle can be completed twice for points. Teams must complete a minimum of one 5-point obstacle, two 3-point obstacles, and 3 single bar jumps.

Class 133 : **JRT High Score Agility Champion & Reserve.** Points will be accumulated from Advanced Agility, Jumpers and Full House (Point Accumulation Game) for the High Point Champion & Reserve. Advanced Agility & Jumpers are each worth 200 points. These points will be combined with the Point Accumulation Game points earned. Jumpers must be a qualifying score (200 points) to earn a High Score Championship, though it does not stop the team from earning a Reserve High Score Championship. If all teams earn faults in the Jumpers class, a Championship can still be awarded to the highest combined point accumulation of the 3 classes. All ties will be broken by the fastest accumulated time of the 3 classes. No entry fee.

Earthdog & Miscellaneous Agility (Non-sanctioned).

Description & Rules are the same as above JRT Beginner Agility & Jumper classes.

- Class 134 : Earthdog Beginner Agility, 1 year & older
- Class 135: Earthdog Jumpers, 1 year & older
- Class 136 : **Miscellaneous Beginner Agility,** 1 year & older, Open to all breeds other than JRTs & Earthdogs.

Saturday (Only)

Nosework Division

Nosework Parameters/Guidelines:

Open to dogs six months & older who are capable of alerting to the target odors. Level 1 target odor is birch. Level 2 target odors can be birch, anise & clove. A Level 1 title is not required to enter Level 2 classes. Owners may enter two dogs in the same class but must either have someone else handle the second dog or wait until the end of the class to allow the judge time to relocate the hide. Teams must go through start-line markers and call "alert" when hides are found. Search areas will be clearly marked. In Level 1 searches, one incorrect call is allowed but incurs a 5-second fault. For Level 2 searches, handlers must call "finish" after the second hide is found. An incorrect call in Level 2 ends the search and results in a non-qualifying run. Time faults incurred for dropped food, failure to go through start-line marker, excessive disturbance of search area, incorrect call in Level 1 and failure to call "finish" in Level 2 searches. Eliminating (pee, poop, or vomit) in a search area ends the search and results in a non-qualifying score and no placement. Consult the rulebook for more detailed information. 1st through 6th place ribbons for each class determined by correct calls with fastest time first. Champion & Reserve Champion ribbons awarded to top two JRT's in Level 1 and top two JRT's in Level 2 by combining scores for all elements/classes. Teams with no faults are considered first.

Class 137 : **JRT Level 1 Container Search.** Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart. Can be set up in 1 straight line or 2 straight rows. Can be cardboard boxes or other containers that are not transparent. Container size must be approximately 6" x 8" and no bigger than 9" x 12". Height must be between 2" & 6".

Class 138 : **JRT Level 1 Exterior Search**. Search area may be natural with light poles, tables, rocks, hard landscape, etc. Could also include added items such as child's toys, logs, boards, wheelbarrows, etc. The search area will be between 100 and 200 square feet & marked with cones, tape, gates fencing, etc.

Class 139 : **JRT Level 2 Container Search.** Consists of 10 to 14 containers spaced at least 2 feet apart in any configuration. Can be any type of container that is not transparent. Containers do not have to be identical and can be elevated.

Class 140 : **JRT Level 2 Exterior Search.** Search area may be natural with light poles, tables, rocks, hard landscape, etc. Could also include added items such as child's toy's, logs, boards, wheelbarrows, etc. Search area will be at least 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Search time is determined by the judge. Hide will not be buried in the ground.

Class 141 : JRT Level 1 Nosework Champion & Reserve. To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 1 classes offered at this trial The scores for Level 1 Container class & Level 1 Exterior class are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion & Reserve Champion ribbons are awarded to the top 2 dogs. No entry fee. Awards sponsored by Catherine Byrne & Pat Weber. Class 142 : JRT Level 2 Nosework Champion & Reserve. To be eligible, dogs must enter all Level 2 classes offered at this trial. The scores for Level 2 Container class & Level 2 Exterior class are combined. Teams with no faults are considered first. Champion & Reserve ribbons are awarded to the top 2 dogs. No entry fee. Awards sponsored by Catherine Byrne & Pat Weber.

Saturday (Only)

Nosework Division

Earthdog Nosework (Non-sanctioned). Open to earthdogs 6 months & older capable of alerting to target odors of birch, anise & clove. Same parameters/guidelines as listed above.

Class 143 : **Earthdog Level 1 Container Search.** . Consists of 8 to 10 identical containers placed on the floor and spaced at least 2 feet apart. Can be set up in 1 straight line or 2 straight rows. Can be cardboard boxes or other containers that are not transparent. Container size must be approximately 6" x 8" and no bigger than 9" x 12". Height must be between 2" & 6".

Class 144 : **Earthdog Level 1 Exterior Search.** Search area may be natural with light poles, tables, rocks, hard landscape, etc. Could also include added items such as child's toys, logs, boards, wheelbarrows, etc. The search area will be between 100 and 200 square feet & marked with cones, tape, gates fencing, etc. Class 145 : **Earthdog Level 2 Container Search.** Consists of 10 to 14 containers spaced at least 2 feet apart in any configuration. Can be any type of container that is not transparent. Containers do not have to be

identical and can be elevated.

Class 146 : **Earthdog Level 2 Exterior Search.** Search area may be natural with light poles, tables, rocks, hard landscape, etc. Could also include added items such as child's toy's, logs, boards, wheelbarrows, etc. Search area will be at least 200 square feet and marked by cones, tape, gates, fencing, etc. Search time is determined by the judge. Hide will not be buried in the ground.

Other Breeds Nosework Practice Runs (Non-sanctioned). Open to all breeds. NOT open to the JRTs & Earthdogs entered in the regular classes at this trial. This is an opportunity to run your other nosework dogs in practice searches. These are the same searches used in the JRT & Earthdog classes described above with the same guidelines/parameters applying. No placement ribbons. \$ 5.00 per run for these practice runs, enter & pay at the Nosework "Sign In" table - Or sign into Trial Vault and enter/pay for these practice runs in the "Add On" Section of Trial Vault.

Saturday & Sunday

Barn Hunt (Non-sanctioned)

This timed event challenges the abilities of the terrier & handler team to locate a live rat, enclosed in a tube, on a straw bale course. When your dog finds a rat, the Judge will stop the clock. No cross-entering between classes. Rules & time limits will be posted near the course.

- Class 147: **JRT Puppy Barn Hunt**, Open to Jack Russell Terrier Puppies, 6 up to 12 months.
- Class 148: JRT Adult Barn Hunt, Open to Adult Jack Russell Terriers, 1 year & older.

- Class 150: JRT Senior Barn Hunt, Open to Senior Jack Russell Terriers, 9 years & older.

Earthdog & Miscellaneous Barn Hunt.

- Class 152 : **Earthdog Barn Hunt**, 6 months & older.
- Class 153 : **Miscellaneous Dog Barn Hunt.** Open to all breeds other than JRT's & Earthdogs, 6 months & older.

Brush Hunt (Non-sanctioned)

Brush Hunt is an above-ground hunting simulation held in a fenced area. One tube containing a live rat is hidden within the brush area. The challenge is for the terrier to use natural instincts to successfully locate and work the quarry. Terrier must find the quarry in the shortest amount of time. The clock starts when the judge is ready and signals you to release your dog at the gate. All four paws must be on the ground before you release your dog. The judge stops the clock when your dog has found the tube. You do not enter the course, but you can encourage your dog verbally. No hand signals allowed. The dog must locate the tube to have a qualifying time. No cross-entering between classes. Maximum time allowed is 2 minutes.

Class 154 : JRT Puppy Brush Hunt, Open to Jack Russell Terrier Puppies, 6 up to 12 months.

- Class 155: JRT Adult Brush Hunt, Open to Adult Jack Russell Terriers, 1 year & older.
- Class 156: JRT Veteran Brush Hunt, Open to Veteran Jack Russell Terriers, 6 years & older.
- Class 157: JRT Senior Brush Hunt, Open to Senior Jack Russell Terriers, 9 years & older.
- Class 158 : **JRT Brush Hunt Champion & Reserve Champion,** Fastest time from all JRT Brush Hunt classes. No entry fee.

Earthdog & Miscellaneous Brush Hunt.

- Class 159: Earthdog Brush Hunt, Open to all Earthdogs other than JRT's, 6 months & older.
- Class 160 : **Miscellaneous Dog Brush Hunt.** Open to all breeds other than JRT's & Earthdogs, 6 months & older.

Saturday & Sunday

Lure Coursing (Non-sanctioned)

This is a timed event in which the dog chases a lure in an enclosed course. Each class entry includes two runs. All runs must be run back-to-back. No cross-entering between classes.

Fastest times from all the over 12 ½" up to 15" JRT Lure classes. No Entry fee.

Earthdog Lure Coursing. Height is limited to Earthdogs 15" and under.

Class 171: Earthdog Lure Coursing. 6 months & older.

Miscellaneous Dog Lure Coursing.

- Class 172 : **Miscellaneous Lure Coursing,** 6 months & older, Open to all breeds other than JRT's & Earthdogs entered in the above JRT or Earthdog classes and over 10" tall.
- Class 173: Shorty Lure Coursing. 6 months & older. Open to all breeds under 10".

Midwest Mayhem (Non-sanctioned)

This is our version of a **Thunder Tunnel**. A fun and interactive tunnel with one side open for viewing your terrier. Each entry includes two tries, run back-to-back. Tunnels will have obstacles & course changes that your terrier will need to problem solve through.

- Class 174: JRT Puppy Midwest Mayhem, 6 up to 12 months.
- Class 175: Adult JRT Midwest Mayhem, 1 year & older.
- Class 176 : Veteran JRT Midwest Mayhem, 6 years 7 older.
- Class 177: Senior JRT Midwest Mayhem, 9 years & older.
- Class 178 : **JRT Midwest Mayhem Champion & Reserve Champion.** Fastest times from all the JRT Midwest Mayhem classes. No entry fee.

Earthdog Midwest Mayhem. Height is limited to Earthdogs 15" and under. Class 179 : **Earthdog Midwest Mayhem**, 6 months & older

Saturday & Sunday

High Points Awards (Non-sanctioned)

Jack Russell Terrier & Earthdogs High-Point Versatility Awards. Points awarded are: 1-point for participation; 2-points for 6th place; 3-points for 5th place; 4-points for 4th place; 5-points for 3rd place; 6-points for 2nd place; 8-points for 1st place. Go To Ground will be the tiebreaker.

Your highest point, from one class in the offered division, will be accumulated each day. The High-Point Versatility Award will be presented at the end of each day. The divisions offered for the award are: Conformation, Racing, Go To Ground, Super Earth, Trailing/Locating, Barn Hunt, Brush Hunt, Lure Coursing, Midwest Mayhem, Agility (except for Puppies), & Nose Work.

To be included in high-point tracking, register your dog in trial Vault by checking the box for the appropriate award from the list that appears at the end of your class choices. No entry fee.

- Class 180 : Jack Russell Terrier PUPPY High-Point Versatility Award. Open to JRT puppies, 6 up to 1 months old.
- Class 181: **ADULT Jack Russell Terrier High-Point Versatility Award** Open to JRT's, 1 year & older.

Friday (Only)

Stakes Barn Hunt Event (Non-sanctioned)

Fun on Friday - Stakes Barn Hunt event held Friday, August 15th from **12:00 – 4:00**. Cost is \$ 20.00 per dog, sign into Trial Vault and enter/pay for the Stakes Barn Hunt Runs in the "Add On" Section of Trial Vault OR enter & pay at the Stakes Barn Hunt "Sign In" table (cash/check only). Maximum of 60 dogs will be allowed to enter. All dogs/all breeds/six months & older are welcome to compete. 50% of the total purse will go to the Summer Celebration Trial as a fund raiser to help cover trial costs. The other 50% will be split up between the fastest 5 qualifying times as follows: 1st place = 30%, 2nd place = 25%, 3rd place = 20%, 4th place = 15%, 5th place = 10%. Awards will be announced at the Friday Potluck Dinner.

There will be 3 rats in tubes, and 1 tube with just litter in it. Each dog has 2:30 minutes on the course to find all 3 rats. At the end of 2:30 minutes, time is up. Dogs who do not find all 3 rats within 2:30 minutes do not have a qualifying time. **As your dog finds each rat, the owner must call it out to the Judge**. The owner must then restrain the dog while the rat handler removes the tube from the course. If the owner does not restrain the dog, the rat handler will not remove the tube. The judge will keep track of the number of rats found. When the dog has found all 3 rats the judge will record the final time.

If the handler calls out "rat" when the dog has actually found a tube with litter, this will cost the dog an additional 10 seconds added to their time. The litter tube will not be removed from the course. If the dog & handler identify the litter tube a second time, it will result in DQ. Handlers can walk along with their dogs and talk to their dogs throughout the course. Handlers cannot touch their dogs nor any part of the course except when restraining their terrier when the rat is being removed from the course. Excessive roughness with the rat may result in DQ by the Judge.

Friday (Only) Brush Hunt Challenge Event (Non-sanctioned)


Fun on Friday – Brush Hunt Challenge event held Friday, August 15th from 12:00 – 4:00. Cost is \$ 5.00 per run, enter as many times as you like. Sign into Trial Vault and enter/pay for the Barn Hunt Challenge runs in the "Add On" section of Trial Vault OR enter/pay at the Brush Hunt Challenge "Sign In" table on Friday (cash/check only). Maximum of 60 dogs will be allowed to enter. All dogs/all breeds/six months & older are welcome to compete.

The clock starts when the judge is ready and signals you to release your dog at the gate. All four paws must be on the ground before you release your dog. **The judge stops the clock when your dog has found the tube**. You do not enter with the dog, but you can encourage your dog verbally. No hand signals allowed. The dog must locate the tube to have a qualifying time. Only your 1st run's time will count towards the 3 Fastest Times of the day. Maximum time allowed is 2 minutes. Top 3 fastest times will win prizes, awarded during the Friday night dinner. Note: The Brush Hunt course will be completely rearranged each day of competition.
