About Us

Who is the JRTCC?

The Jack Russell Terrier Club of Canada Inc. (JRTCC) is the national club for Jack Russell Terrier fans, with provincial affiliates throughout Canada. Founded in 1989 and incorporated in 1991, the Club is an affiliate of the Jack Russell Terrier Club of Great Britain. Our members include internationally recognized breeders, working terrier people and pet owners.

Our Mission

The Club and its affiliates are dedicated to preserving the working Jack Russell Terrier (JRT), and proudly maintain the national registry for the Jack Russell Terrier in Canada. Our guiding principle is to promote the breed's historic conformation while keeping the working ability in the forefront. In other words, our goal is that the Jack Russell Terrier should remain a bright, alert, well-rounded dog, with the form, endurance and drive to go to ground after their quarry.

Important Notice

Before the COVID-19 pandemic, the JRTCC National Trial attracted over 200 dogs, many of them from the American club, the JRTCA. Since then, we have struggled to attract as many American members as we did previously, and this has had a negative impact on our revenues, making it a challenge to cover all our costs.

We value our American members, particularly for their contributions as judges and volunteers at our National Trial. The JRTCC board has carefully considered our viability, and we believe that we can make it as a mostly Canadian club, but we will have to make some changes and find new ways of generating revenue.

In the past several years, we have added new breeders, newer and younger board members, and have actively collaborated with the Jack Russell Terrier Rescue of Ontario (JRTRO). We are in a phase of rebuilding, and have plans to increase both membership and revenues, and support our mission as the original registry for the Jack Russell Terrier in Canada, in affiliation with our sister clubs. A key piece of our plans for revenues is to begin hosting Rats! Canada Trials, which is a multi-breed organization. The JRTCC has been approved by the Rats! Canada board as a trial host, and we plan to begin hosting trials in spring 2026. We will provide more details on these plans at our AGM.

After polling our registered breeders, we are also making some minor, cost-saving changes to our registry and certificates, which include having electronic submission of forms and electronic distribution of registration and trial certificates. All requirements will remain the same. There will be a short seminar on this on Friday evening after the costume classes, and a Q&A prior to the Annual General Meeting.

As a result, this year's National Trial is being run on a reduced budget, and one of the changes we have made is scaling back on the prizes awarded in each class. Despite this, we are confident it will still be a wonderful weekend—full of excitement for the dogs and great fun for everyone attending.

We truly appreciate your understanding and continued support, and we look forward to sharing this special event with you.

General Information and Rules

New For Exhibition Only (FEO) Classes This Year

To increase revenue we created FEO classes for all Jack Russell Terriers for non-registered and/or non-recorded dogs to participate in Performance Championship classes (Racing, Go To Ground, Super Earth). Please note, the FEO classes will have separate regular first to sixth place placing. Dogs entered in this FEO class are NOT eligible for any championship or reserve placements place.

Participation Requirements for People and Terriers:

- All classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
- All terriers must register in their age group only for duration of the National trial.
- Exhibitors and owners must be current voting members of the JRTCC. Associate members may upgrade their membership at any time prior to applying for entry in the National Trial.
- Veteran Terriers 6 years and older / Senior Terriers 9 years and older.
- All terriers over one year of age, participating in sanctioned_events, must be registered, or recorded with the JRTCC or JRTCA or JRTCGB. Those events include Racing, Conformation, Go to Ground, Super Earth, Agility. Registration/Recording numbers MUST be included with entries and copies of applicable certificates are also requested.
- Any non-registered/unrecorded terriers over one year of age may participate in non-sanctioned events only (Note: Rules of Competition). Those events are Barn Hunt, Trailing & Locating, Lure Coursing, Brush Hunt, Ball Retrieval, Rally O, Tunnellers, Rumble Tunnel, Companion Pet/Rescue, Barn Hunt Rat Dash, and GTG Stakes.
- Bitches in season <u>and</u> Puppies under 3 months of age are not permitted on the trial grounds, thus may not compete in any division. Any exhibitor showing either will be excused, with no refunds, from ALL classes and directed to leave the trial site.
- All changes/moves within Conformation to be completed <u>1 hour</u> prior to any Conformation classes starting each day of the trial.
- Racing and agility does not accept same day entries.
- New members wishing to exhibit may submit membership applications/dues, with entries, by the deadline.
- The sale, advertising signage and/or placement of puppies or adult terriers on the trial grounds are forbidden. Any person violating this rule will be excused, with no refunds, from ALL classes and directed to leave the trial site.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to be on time for every class and to be aware of the scheduled classes in each division. **No refunds for missed classes.**
- The judge's decision concerning placements are final in all divisions.

- Please remember to pick up after your dogs while at the trial site. If you see someone who does not, please politely offer them a baggie.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated at any time. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship, or rude behavior will be dismissed from all classes and asked to leave the trial grounds. No refunds will be given.
- Please abide by the Rules of the Venue No alcohol, cannabis, smoking, vaping, etc. in public areas. Judges must not eat, smoke, or use cell phones while at their event.

Pre-Entries

- Pre-entries must be received online by September 2nd, 2025 at 11:59PM (EST).
- Pre-Entry fees are \$15 per class.
- Entries after September 2nd, 2025 are \$20 per class.
- Online Entries close on September 12, 2025 at 11:59PM
- Same day entry fees are \$20 per class.
- The JRTCC Administration Fee of \$5 per terrier is added to the total entry fee.
- Full payment must accompany the entry form.
- Same day entries will be accepted on the day of the trial for all events EXCEPT Racing and Agility.
- Copies of Hunting and/or Trial Certificates, if applicable, must uploaded to Trial Vault and reviewed by judges prior to the trial.
- Please verify all your entries before you submit. We are not responsible for wrong class entries that you have made.
- A valid Vet Certificate must accompany all requests submitted to the JRTCC for monetary refunds related to any scratched entries. Approved refunds will be provided within 30 days of the trial. Any extraneous situation at the trial will be directed to the Trial Chairs.

Running Order

• Judges and volunteers are allowed to jump to the front of the line, ahead of other competitors during the weekend to get their run in on time and return to their judging and/or volunteer tasks.

Registration Desk

- Open for package pickup on Friday at 6:30pm; Saturday and Sunday early morning.
- We kindly ask that you avoid the registration desk one hour prior to the award ceremony on Saturday and Sunday to allow for a timely processing of trial results.
- Scoring binders are off limits to competitors unless approved by a Trial Chair, Trial Secretary, or Judge. DO NOT TAKE A SCORING BINDER WITHOUT PERMISSION or you will be disqualified and asked to leave the trial.
- Participants are only allowed to request to see a scoring binder AFTER the award ceremony on both Saturday and Sunday.

Sportsmanship

Sportsmanship is at the heart of everything we do at the Jack Russell Terrier Club of Canada's National Trial. Whether you're a seasoned competitor or a first-time participant, the spirit of respect, camaraderie, and fairness defines the experience for both humans and their dogs. We believe that celebrating each other's successes, supporting fellow competitors, and handling both victories and setbacks with grace are what truly elevate our community. Good sportsmanship fosters a positive environment where everyone feels welcome, encouraged, and proud to be part of something bigger than themselves—our shared love for the Jack Russell Terrier and the values that unite us as a club.

Anyone exhibiting poor sportsmanship or rudeness toward a judge, trial chair, committee member, or fellow participant will be immediately asked to leave the grounds, and no refund will be issued.

Land Acknowledgment

"We acknowledge that we are on the traditional territory of the Anishnawbe, Haudenosaunee and Neutral peoples. In Kitchener, Waterloo, Cambridge and Brantford we are on the traditional territory of the Neutral, Anishnawbe and Haudenosaunee peoples."

Anishnawbe peoples: Also known as Ojibway/Chippewa/Mississauga/Algonquin, their original ancestral home was located on the north shore of Lake Huron, at the mouth of the Mississagi River. During the 17th century, the Anishnawbe split, with groups migrating east to the Bay of Quinte and South into what is now known as south-western Ontario (from Toronto to Lake Erie). During the 18th century, the Anishnawbe began losing land due to European settlement and the northern movement of the Haudenosaunee into south-western Ontario. Today, Anishnawbe in south-western Ontario include the Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation, Aamjiwnaang, Chippewas of the Thames First Nation, and the Chippewas of Kettle and Stony Point.

Haudenosaunee peoples: Also known as Six Nations and Iroquois, are various nations that formed what is known as the Haudenosaunee Confederacy. It originally consisted of five Nations: Cayuga, Oneida, Onondaga, Mohawk, and Seneca, but in 1722, the Tuscarora joined to form the Six Nations. The Haudenosaunee reside in parts of Ontario and Upstate New York. The largest reserve in North America is the Six Nations of the Grand River, located near Branford, Ontario. Other communities where Haudenosaunee reside include Tyendinaga, Awkwesasne, and Oneida Nation of the Thames, to name a few.

Neutral peoples: Called the Neutrals due to their tendency to avoid conflict, and "Attawandaron" by the Hurons. They are made up of many distinct nations. They were decimated by colonial diseases during early colonization and any remaining members were mostly adopted into the Haudenosaunee Confederacy.

Kitchener-Waterloo and Brantford are both located on the Haldimand Tract, which, on October 25, 1784, after the American Revolutionary War of Independence, was given to the Six Nations of the Grand River and Mississaugas of the Credit First Nation by the British as compensation for their role in the war and for the loss of their traditional lands in Upstate New York (www.sixnations.ca, http://mncfn.ca). Of the 950,000 acres given to the Haudenosaunee (six miles on either side of the Grand River, all the way along its length), only 46,000 acres (less than 5 per cent) remain Six Nations land (www.sixnations.ca) and 6,100 acres remain Mississaugas of the Credit land.

- On August 1st, 2024 new rules impacting the entry of dogs into the United States from other countries, such as Canada, become effective.
- It is the sole responsibility of the member to ensure they follow the rules implemented by the CDC and USDA.
- There will be NO refunds for entries withdrawn after the closing date.
- Refunds will only be provided for injured dogs, provided notification is received prior to the first day of the national event.
- Refund requests MUST is accompanied by a veterinarian's (DVM) certificate. No other professional certification will be accepted.


Dog Safety



GAME: BARN-HUNT RAT DASH (NON-SANCTIONED)

There will be 5 rats in tubes, and 3 tubes with just litter in them. Each dog has 3 minutes 30 seconds on the course to find all 5 rats. Dogs who do not find all 5 rats within 3 minutes 30 seconds do not have a qualifying time. When the dog finds a rat, the owner must call it out to the judge. The owner must then restrain the dog while the rat handler removes the tube from the course. If the owner does not restrain the dog, the rat handler will not remove the tube. The judge will keep track of the number of rats found. When the dog has found all 5 rats the judge will record final time. If the handler calls out "rat" when the dog has actually found a tube with litter, this will cost the dog an additional 10 seconds added to their time. If the dog and handler identify a litter tube a second time, it will result in DQ. Dogs may only run the course once.50% of the total purse will go to JRTCC to help cover overall trial costs. The other 50% will be awarded, split up between the top 6 qualifying times as follows: 1st place = 29%, 2nd place = 24%, 3rd place = 19%, 4th place = 14%, 5th place = 9%, 6th place = 5%. The "Puppy Purse" will be split between only pups. Puppies 6 - 12 are eligible to compete. The course will be the same as what the adults run, but the puppies' times will only compete with other puppies. The adult class will include all dogs; adult, veteran, and senior. Please verify our Rulebook for full details.


GAME: GO-TO-GROUND STAKES (NON-SANCTIONED)

The starting line shall be placed two feet from the entrance hole. Timing starts when the terrier is released by the handler. The Judge signals the release of the terrier. The terrier is to be released so that all four feet are on the ground before crossing the starting line. The terrier may not be pushed or thrown toward the hole. Any violation of this rule, accidental or intentional, shall result in disqualification of the terrier from the class in which the violation occurs. No entry fees will be refunded. After the terrier is released, the handler shall remain next to the entrance hole. Once the terrier has entered, the handler may not block the entrance hole by standing in it or in any other manner. Commands and encouragement may be given. The handler shall wait for the signal from the Judge before proceeding to the terrier's location to pick up the terrier. \$20 per dog. Dogs may only run the course once.50% of the total purse will go to JRTCC to help cover overall trial costs. The other 50% will be awarded, split up between the top 6 qualifying times as follows: 1st place = 29%, 2nd place = 24%, 3rd place = 19%, 4th place = 14%, 5th place = 9%, 6th place = 5%The "Puppy Purse" will be split between only pups. Puppies 6 - 12 months are eligible to compete. The course will be the same as what the adults run, but the puppies' times will only compete with other puppies. The adult class will include all dogs; adult, veteran, and senior. Unsportsmanlike behavior will result in DQ of that handler and dog team. Please verify our Rulebook for full details.
