# GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT organization. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. **Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.**
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. **Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family\*, Open or Working Conformation. \*Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.**
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. **Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds; this rule applies to RV's and campers if at the same address as the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site.**
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. **Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.**
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office (410-561-3655) or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website [www.therealjackrussell.com](http://www.therealjackrussell.com)
21. **Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.**
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA sanctioned trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. Judges must not eat, smoke, vape or use cell phones while judging their events.
24. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION IS FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS. All rules must be followed.**

# STAKES BARN HUNT

**FRIDAY, NOVEMBER 7th, 11:00am - 4:00pm**

This year at the SWJRTN Fall Festival we will hold a Stakes Barn Hunt. Friday, November 7th, from 11:00am - 4:00pm; sign up will start at 10:30am that morning.

Cost is \$20.00 per dog, cash payment only, no trial vault, pay at the barn hunt course. A maximum of 50 dogs will be allowed to run. All dogs, all breeds, all ages over 4 months are allowed to compete.

50% of total purse goes to SWJRTN as a fund raiser to help cover material costs. The other 50% will be split up between the 5 fastest qualifying times as follows: 1st = 30%, 2nd = 25%, 3rd = 20%, 4th = 15%, 5th = 10%. Awards will be announced Friday night at the potluck dinner.

## **HERE ARE THE RULES...PLEASE READ THEM!!!**

There will be 3 rats in tubes and 1 tube with just litter in it. Each dog has 2 minutes 30 seconds on the course to find all 3 rats. At the end of 2 minutes 30 seconds, time is up. Dogs who do not find the 3 rats will NOT have a qualifying time. When the dog finds a rat, the handler must call it out to the Judge. The owner must then either restrain their dog or hand the rat tube to the Rat Wrangler, if the handler does not restrain their dog or hand the tube to Rat Wrangler, the tube will remain on the course. When the dog has found all 3 rats, the Judge will record final time.

If the handler calls "rat" when the dog actually found the litter, it will cost the dog, and an additional 10 seconds will be added to their time. The litter tube is not removed from the course. If the dog and handler identify the litter tube a second time, it will result in a DQ.

Handlers can walk and talk with their dogs throughout the course, however, the handler cannot touch their dog or any part of the course except after the rat is called and is being removed.

When restraining/praising the dog, at least 2 feet must remain in contact with the ground/hay bales.

Dogs may not bite or lay teeth on the Rat Wrangler while rat tube is being removed from the course. This will result in an immediate DQ and dog & handler will be asked to leave the course. The Rat Wrangler will not pick up the tube to remove it until the handler has effectively restrained their dog.

Dogs should not be allowed to excessively rough the tube. Excessive play with the rat may result in DQ by Judge.

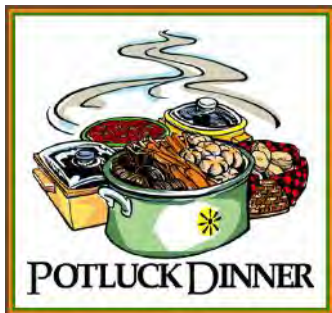

No guarantee is made regarding the completeness or accuracy of these instructions. Construction projects, traffic, or other events may cause actual conditions to differ from these results. It's always best to consult a map if you're unsure of where you're going.

#### **FROM DALLAS: Approximate Drive Time: 1 hour & 15 minutes**

Drive East on I-30 for about an hour. Take exit 122 toward Cooper Lake/State Park, go 0.1 mi and then merge onto I-30 Frontage Rd and proceed 0.4 mi. Turn right onto the TX-19 N ramp and go 0.2 mi. Turn right onto TX-19 N/Hillcrest Dr. S and drive 1.6 mi, then turn right onto Houston St; trial site will be on the right after approximately 0.7 mi.

#### **FROM HOUSTON: Approximate Drive Time: 4 hours & 30 minutes**

Drive North on I-45 towards Dallas. Take exit 178 for US-79 toward Buffalo; drive 0.3 miles then turn right onto US-79 N/W Commerce St. Continue to follow US-79 N for 33 mi. Nearing Palestine, turn left onto TX-256 Loop W and proceed 1.6 mi. Take the TX-19 N/US-287 N ramp, drive 0.2 mi and then turn left onto TX-19 N/W Spring St. and drive for 30.3 mi. Continue onto TX-19 BUS N/S Palestine St and follow TX-19 BUS N for 4.2 mi. Continue onto TX-19 S for 66.3 mi. In Sulphur Springs, TX-19 becomes Hillcrest Dr. S; turn right onto Houston St; trial site will be on the right after 0.7 miles.

# **RACING**

## **CLASSES WILL BE RUN IN THE BELOW SEQUENCE**

**THERE WILL BE THREE (3) CALLS FOR RACING - ABSOLUTELY NO EXCEPTIONS**

**All terriers must be muzzled to race. NO COLORED MUZZLES ALLOWED. ONLY BLACK, BROWN, CLEAR OR WHITE MUZZLES MAY BE USED. NO BASKERVILLE MUZZLES ALLOWED.** To be eligible to be in the Championship, terriers must be entered and finish both flats and hurdles. You **MUST** have your Jack ON-DECK and securely muzzled in order to race. If you need help, please ask for it in advance. **DO NOT** wait until it's time to load into the starting boxes. **BE PREPARED.**

A. A terrier **MUST ENTER AND FINISH** in both, at least one flat race AND one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final),

B. A **FINISHED** race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier.

C. Terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first thru the backside of the barrier. (01/22)

D. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.

### **PUPPY FLAT RACES**

- Class 1** Pups, 4 up to 6 months (**Non-Sanctioned**)
- Class 2** Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12.5"
- Class 3** Pups, 6 up to 9 months, over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 4** Pups, 9 up to 12 months, up to 12.5"
- Class 5** Pups, 9 up to 12 months, over 12.5" up to 15"

### **SENIOR FLAT RACES**

(No cross-entering into any other flat races)

- Class 6** Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 7** Senior Dogs, 9 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 8** Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 9** Senior Bitches, 9 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15"

### **ADULT FLAT RACES**

- Class 10** Dogs, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 11** Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 12** Bitches, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 13** Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12.5" up to 15"

### **VETERAN FLAT RACES**

(No cross-entering into any other flat races)

- Class 14** Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 15** Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15"
- Class 16** Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12.5"
- Class 17** Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, over 12.5" up to 15"

## **PUPPY STEEPLECHASE RACES** (Puppies race over low hurdles, up to 8")

**Class 19** Pups, 6 up to 9 months, up to 12.5"

## **GO-TO-GROUND**

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. **\*Electric Timers Are Used\***

- **Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Any violation of this rule shall result in disqualification for the Go-To-Ground competition at this trial. See posted rules at this event.**
- **FOR ALL CLASSES:** Work is defined as baying, digging, concentrated stare, whining or biting at the bars. A break in work is defined as ceasing to work for a period of more than ten seconds. Leaving the quarry is defined as moving back in the tunnel away from the quarry and out of view of the judge. The judge may halt the work if the judge believes the terrier is injuring itself. Terrier is not to leave quarry once it is reached. Must work quarry continuously for one full minute without break in work unless noted.
- No adult terrier may compete in the Champion Certificate class until the Trial Certificate has been applied for, issued, and received.
- For all Champion Certificate classes, copies of the JRTCA GTG Trial Certificate must be submitted with pre-entries or presented to the den steward at the time of judging.

**Class 44** **PRE-NOVICE PUPPY** Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in pre-novice class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice class after 6 mos. of age. (1 minute to reach quarry, may leave earth and re-enter, mark quarry for a full 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another. Examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

***\*Terriers, puppies and adults, registered or non-registered, which have previously scored 100% in the Novice Class at a JRTCA trial may not, under any circumstances, compete in these classes again, at any JRTCA Sanctioned Trial.***

**Class 45** **NOVICE PUPPY** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).



**Class 46**     **NOVICE ADULT**    Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another (examples baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

**Class 47**     **OPEN PUPPY**    Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial **OR** may continue competing in Open Puppy Go-To-Ground class at future trials. (1 second per foot to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.) **Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.**

*Terriers, 1 year old or older, registered or non-registered, which have previously scored 100% in the Open Class, may continue to compete in the Open Adult Class until they receive their Trial Certificate. A terrier achieving 100% in the Open Adult Class is eligible to apply for a Trial Certificate when the terrier is registered or recorded with the JRTCA. No adult terrier may compete in the Championship Certificate class until the Trial Certificate has been applied for and issued.*

**Class 48**     **OPEN ADULT**    Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. (1 second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one type of work to another.)

A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.
- Class 70** **SENIOR, 10" UP TO 12.5" CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE** Open to Jack Russell Terriers, 10" up to 12.5", nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.
- Class 71** **SENIOR, OVER 12.5" UP TO 15" CHAMPIONSHIP CERTIFICATE** Open to Jack Russell Terriers, over 12.5" up to 15", nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

## **YOUTH**

All Child and Youth Handlers are invited to participate in our opening ceremonies after the Racing awards inside the Conformation Ring. Child and Youth Handler classes will begin promptly after the opening ceremonies and before the other Conformation Classes. The **SANCTIONED** Youth Division is open to JRTCA Child and/or Youth members in the following brackets: Child Handler (ages 5-9) and Youth Handler (ages 10-16). A Child/Youth exhibitor's age is determined as of January 1st of the current calendar year except for those children turning 5 years of age; they may start competing in Child Handler any time of the year following their 5th birthday.

**The points awarded to both Child and Youth Handler High Score are as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points, 4th = 4 points, 5th = 3 points; 6th place = 2 points, and participation = 1 point.**

- Class 72** **Child Handler.** Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. ***Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.***
- Class 73** **Child Go-To-Ground.** Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling a Jack Russell Terrier, six months of age or older. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. ***If a terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before it can compete in Child Go-To-Ground. (Non-Sanctioned)***
- Class 74** **CHILD HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE (NO ENTRY FEE)** Awarded to the highest scoring and runner-up classes 72 & 73. ***(Non-Sanctioned)***
- Class 75** **Youth Handler.** Open to any youth, aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. ***Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.***
- Class 76** **Youth Working Judge's Choice.** Open to any youth handler aged 10 through 16 handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge. No terrier to accompany

handler in class.

**Class 77 Youth Go-To-Ground.** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog's knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10-foot Novice tunnel; time not to be considered. **If a terrier is competing in a regular GTG class, it needs to run in the regular GTG class before it can compete in Youth Go-To-Ground.**

**Class 78 YOUTH HANDLER HIGH SCORE & RESERVE (NO ENTRY FEE)** Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in classes 75,76 & 77.

Exhibitors must compete in a minimum of Youth Handling and Youth Go-to-Ground to qualify for the Youth High Score & Reserve. A tie will be broken with the final decision made by a Conformation Judge other than the Judge of the day. The tiebreaker takes place in the conformation ring and is determined at the Judge's discretion by the exhibitor's handling/presentation of his/her terrier, by the answers to the Judge's questions, or by a combination of the two.

## **CONFORMATION**

**PLEASE REMEMBER TO EXIT THE RING ON THE SOUTH SIDE. SCRATCHES OR ADDS TO CONFORMATION MUST BE MADE BEFORE 11:00 AM EACH DAY.**

All terriers are judged on the JRTCA breed standard except for Child/Youth handlers where the conformation of the terrier is not considered and judging is based on the Child/Youth handler's ability. All terriers must be exhibited on-lead. **Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open and Working sections.** JRTCA Working Conformation is open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRTCA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate (NHC). A copy of the NHC must be submitted with pre-entry or presented in the ring at the time of judging.

**Class 79 Costume Class. SATURDAY ONLY** Come have fun & dress up with your dog in a fun, free contest! Open to all exhibitors and terriers from all Divisions. **(Non-Sanctioned)**

## **FAMILY CLASSES**

**Class 80 Stud Dog & Get.** Open to a sire with at least two, but no more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Stud Dog must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spay/neutered.

**Class 81 Brood Bitch & Produce.** Open to a dam with at least two, but no more than three offspring at parent's side. Judged on Breed Standard and consistency of type. Brood Bitch must be intact. Offspring may be intact or spay/neutered.

**Class 82 BEST FAMILY & RESERVE (NO ENTRY FEE)** Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of Class 80 & 81.

**Class 83 3 UP TO 4 Month Puppy Class** This class is for puppies 3 months old up to 4 months old. It is a "fun" class for you to showcase your up and coming pups. **Please refer to page 2, Rule 14:** puppies MUST meet on-site age requirements. **(Non-Sanctioned)**

Registration of Jack Russell Terriers (or any variant thereof) with any all-breed kennel club, or membership in any organization that supports all-breed kennel club recognition/registration, is not acceptable for application to membership in the JRTCA.

The Jack Russell Terrier is a unique working terrier that has remained virtually unchanged for more than 100 years because it has been preserved for work. It is an unspoiled type or strain of working terrier with unique character, working ability, great intelligence, sound physical structure, and broad structural differences within the standard. These characteristics must be maintained to preserve this terrier as it remains today. The JRTCA's unique registry, with its strict inbreeding limitations and health requirements, breed standard, Breeders' Code of Ethics, and working certificate, sanctioned judge and field trial programs are all designed to do just that. All those who support the JRTCA's principles are welcome and encouraged to join the JRTCA and help us preserve this great little terrier.
