# Racing

<u>RACING</u> – Racing will begin promptly at <u>10:00 AM</u>. All terriers including 3-6 month puppies must have "closed end" muzzles for racing. (Muzzles will be available on site for purchase or loan.) No cross entering between adult and veteran classes. <u>NOTES:</u> The track will be 250-300 feet in length with 4 hurdles. For this event, hurdles will be <u>LOW</u> for <u>ALL</u> age groups. Dogs *MAY* enter both the maiden class and their regular class in racing ONLY.

#### **SUPER EARTH** - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry

<u>THUNDER TUNNEL – Judge: Emory Vaughn</u> This is a timed event with the terrier working their way through an above ground tunnel. One side of the tunnel is clear. Each terrier runs the tunnel twice and the better of the two times is the final time posted. You may pay at the gate but will be charged the post entry price. (The tie breaker will be the dogs second time.)

- Class 50 Pups, 4 up to 12 months
- Class 51 Maiden Terrier, Any Adult Terrier, 10" up to 15", who has never placed 1st in a class (MAY cross enter)
- Class 52 Adult Terriers, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 53 Adult Terriers, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 54 Veteran Terriers, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 55 Veteran Terriers, 6 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 56 Senior Terriers, 9 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"
- Class 57 Senior Terriers, 9 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 58 Other Terrier, 6 months & older

**BRUSH HUNT** Can your terrier find the quarry? Time starts when the handler releases the terrier. After one minute, the handler may assist the terrier in locating the quarry. JUDGE determines when the terrier locates and/or works the quarry.

- Class 59 Puppies, 4 up to 12 months
- Class 60 Maiden Terrier, Any Adult Terrier, 10" up to 15", who has never placed 1st in a class (MAY cross enter)
- Class 61 Adult Terriers, 1 year and older
- Class 62 Veteran Terriers, 6 years and older
- Class 63 Senior Terriers, 9 years and older
- Class 64 Other Terrier, 6 months & older

**<u>FIELD LURE COURSING</u>** -This is a timed event with terrier chasing the lure. Fastest time of the two runs qualifies for ribbons  $1^{st} - 6^{th}$ .

- Class 65 Puppy, 6 up to 12 months, up to 12 ½"
- Class 66 Puppy, 6 up to 12 months, over 12 ½" up to 15"
- Class 67 Adults, 10" up to 12 ½". Open to terriers 1 yr and older
- Class 68 Adults, 12 ½" up to 15". Open to terriers 1 yr and older
- Class 69 Veterans, 10" up to 12 ½". Open to terriers 6 yr and older
- Class 70 Veterans, 12 1/2" up to 15". Open to terriers 6 yr and older
- Class 71 Seniors, 10" up to 12 ½". Open to terriers 9 yr and older
- Class 72 Seniors, 12 ½" up to 15". Open to terriers 9 yr and older
- Class 73 OTHER, 6 months & over, not registerable or recordable with the JRTCA i.e. colored or other earth working terriers
- Class 74 UNDER Champion & Reserve; awarded to the first and second fastest times each day of all the under classes. No entry fee.
- Class 75 OVER Champion & Reserve; awarded to the first and second fastest times each day of all the over classes. No entry fee.

Classes are \$7.00 each if mailed by November 23, 2025. You can also do online entries using the new updated Trial Vault at <a href="v3.trialvault.dog">v3.trialvault.dog</a>. Pre-entries close for online November 30, 2025. (Please note you must make an account on the updated version of trial vault, if you have not already done so).

We will be using Trial Vault for entries so you can go to v3.trialvault.dog and create your own account.

Water, restroom facilities and a bath house will be available at the trial site.



Please keep in mind that Camp Harmony is a bit rustic, we do not recommend that you try to park your camper in the camping spaces after dark since there are numerous trees in the parking area. We recommend that you run the water until clear before hooking to your camper. We do recommend that you use the Harmony Road entrance to the camp if you bring a camper or class A since it is a more direct path to the camping area.

Please keep your dogs on a leash, there is a large flock of Canada geese in residence on the pond.

#### Camping

Camping is available at the trial site for \$20 per night. Most camp sites have electricity and water, but some may be hard to get in to. First come, first serve. 30-amp services available so be prepared with adapters. You also may want to be prepared to Dry Camp, just in case.

The Trial Site Camp Harmony is around 40 minutes from the I85 Lavonia Ga exit.

There are 2 Bunk House Cabins available for \$20 per night, per person. They both have bathrooms and heating. There is only 1 room with 30 bunks in each cabin. The cabins can be Co-ed or we can plan to have a male cabin and a female cabin. This will depend on how many want to stay in the cabins. Please be prepared to bring sleeping bag and or blankets and linens. There will be enough room in the cabins for everyone to have their dogs and crates. But be aware your dogs have to be crated in the Bunk Houses for everyone's safety. Please mark on your registration if you would like to Cabin Camp.

There are Hotels in Elberton and Hartwell, some Dog Friendly, some not. Call to verify. Richard B Russell State Park has Cabins to rent, about 20 minutes away.

\*\*\* Note, All racing terriers, <u>including puppies</u>, must be muzzled.\*\*\* Only closed end muzzles are allowed. No Mikki or figure eight muzzles\*\*\* Please no brightly colored basket muzzles

All puppies must be current on their vaccinations and no puppies under 3 months of age will be allowed at the trial. No Exceptions. No puppy sales at trial site. No puppies under 3 months of age in RV's. If you have young puppies, please bring a Stud Certificate to verify age. This will be strictly enforced. You will be asked to leave and no refunds will be given.

There will be no food service available at the camp and the towns of Elberton and Hartwell are about 15 minutes away so plan accordingly.

REFUNDS for classes will be given ONLY in cases of accident or illness of a terrier or owner, or for bitches in season. Situations must be documented in writing. Refunds provided by mail within 14 days following the trial.
