JRTCA membership does not apply to owners of other breed dogs

GENERAL RULES FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members, and must not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months of age) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season to be refunded with vet certificate from owner, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Working (with a working certificate) and Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family* or Open Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the Conformation Division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling classes.
9. Terriers owned by Judges may not be entered in the division in which they are judging, but may enter the competition in any other division.
10. Terriers owned by Stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes or Certificate Go-To-Ground/Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den Steward at the time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered, and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RVs & camps, if at the same address as the trial grounds).
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off leash work. No liberty leashes allowed
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse of dogs or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double-check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be obtained by contacting the JRTCA office 410-561-3655; or it can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties, which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their sole and absolute discretion.
22. All dogs brought to JRTCA Sanctioned Trials must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious diseases.
23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their events. (01/22)
24. **THE JUDGE'S DECISION CONCERNING PLACEMENTS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS!**

IMPORTANT TRIAL INFORMATION

Please familiarize yourself with the notes and rules listed below.
Everything will run more smoothly if everyone knows the information provided.

Competing adult, Jack Russells, registered/recorded with the JRTCA Terriers & puppies pay a \$2.00 per dog, per day, JRTCA Administration Fee. If your Jack Russell has not been registered or recorded, you will have to pay the regular \$2.00 fee plus an additional \$5.00 per dog, per day. All admin fees are turned in to the JRTCA.

ENTRIES MUST BE POSTMARKED BY FRIDAY, APRIL 3, 2026

All mailed entries postmarked after 4/10/26 will be considered post-entries, and you will be charged accordingly. **NO Phone Entries.** We highly encourage emailing your entry to the Trial Secretary, at PLRJACKS@GMAIL.COM, along with copies of your current JRTCA Membership certificate, & any applicable Certificates (NHC, GTG, etc). **Emailed entries must be received by MONDAY, APRIL 10TH** and will receive confirmation of receipt, (please note: regular mailed entries generally will not receive a confirmation email – feel free to reach out to verify receipt), if you have not received your confirmation email by April 15, 2026, please contact the Trial Secretary.

CERTIFICATES: Please include copies of the necessary certificates with your pre-entries for the Working Division, GTG, Super Earth and/or Agility. **The trial secretary makes no assumptions.** If the appropriate certificate is not included, your dog will be entered in the **open class -- NOT the certificate class.**

NO POST ENTRIES for RACING, except as available to fill heats.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO PICK UP AFTER YOUR DOGS WHILE AT THE TRIAL SITE. If you see someone who does not, please politely offer them a baggie.

REMINDER: Please follow the rules of your hotel/accommodations regarding your dogs; clean up after them on the grounds, no grooming in rooms or site, and please be a good representative of your club.

It is the intent of club members to provide a trial that is enjoyable for all participants. As a result, **UNSPORTSMANLIKE CONDUCT WILL NOT BE TOLERATED** at any time. Anyone demonstrating poor sportsmanship, rude behavior or causing trouble in any manner will be dismissed from all classes and asked to leave the trial grounds. No refunds will be given.

Please abide by the Rules of the Venue – No alcohol, cannabis, smoking, etc., in public areas.

Every effort will be made to start Trial events on time. Dogs late to racing or conformation will be scratched. Every effort has been made to schedule trial events such that exhibitors may enter as many classes as possible. However, several events must run concurrently, thus some conflicts are unavoidable. **It is the responsibility of the EXHIBITOR to be aware of the scheduled classes and be on time for the classes they have entered.** The trial committee is not responsible for class conflicts that may arise and classes will not be held up for these conflicts. Please carefully review the class list and agenda and plan your entries accordingly. **No refunds for missed classes!**

NO PUPPIES under 3 months of age, or BITCHES IN HEAT, allowed on the trial grounds FOR ANY REASON.

There is no charge for Child/Youth Entries. CHILDREN must remain under adult supervision at all times.

MEASUREMENTS of borderline-sized or disputed terriers will be performed by a sanctioned judge a minimum of 30 minutes before **Racing** or **Conformation** starts. Conformation measurements will be performed by the Conformation judge or their designee ****before**** the start of Conf. classes. The judge, however, may call for a measurement once a class begins. Measurements made at this time will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial.

RINGSIDE SPACE: Available for the weekend for \$25.00 for a 10 X 10 space. Ringside seating will be assigned.

SPONSORSHIPS: Please sign up to sponsor a class. Sponsorships help pay for ribbons, trophies, judges and other trial expenses. See included sponsorship form.

VENDORS ARE WELCOME FOR THE WEEKEND! There is a \$25 fee. Please indicate on your entry form if you would like a vendor space.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED – As with any trial, there is a **lot of work** involved. We appreciate any help with the many jobs needing to be done to make this a successful trial. Please ask about volunteering by email or at the registration table.

AWARDS are given out throughout the weekend; there is no set award time!

Please do not enter classes w/ grayed out class numbers. If you qualify, you will automatically be entered.



Driving Directions:



DIVISION A: RACING

- **ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED!** Plastic basket muzzles or closed-ended cloth muzzles **ONLY**. Figure eight & open-ended muzzles are **NOT** allowed, No exceptions.
- **ATTENTION: JRTCA RULE FOR RACING MUZZLES – NO COLORED MUZZLES ALLOWED. White, Black, Brown/Tan, & Clear muzzles are allowed.**
- Terriers **MUST ENTER** both flats & hurdles **AND FINISH** in both, at least one flat race **AND** one hurdle race and place first in at least one of their finals to compete in Championship races.
- Seniors run over low hurdles, up to 8 inches.
- No cross-entering between regular Adult classes, Veteran classes, Senior classes, or sanctioned and non-sanctioned classes.
- Races will be run in the sequence posted in this Trial Premium.
- **Please HAVE YOUR TERRIER ON DECK AND MUZZLED. Please listen for class announcements! If you need assistance please ask; we are here to help.**
- **PLEASE BE CONSIDERATE OF OTHER COMPETITORS.**
- **4-6 month puppies do not run hurdles nor qualify for Puppy Championship.**



DIVISION B: GO-TO-GROUND

Section 1. Go-To-Ground – Open

Please note: The youth run as a group and GTG will open to them first.

Regular GTG will open to everyone after the youth are finished.

- Class 45 **Pre-Novice Puppy** Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 to 6 months of age. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)
- Class 46 **Novice Puppy** Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another - examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).
- Class 47 **Novice Adult** Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without break in work and without leaving the quarry; may switch from one type of work to another -- examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying).
- NOTE: If a terrier has passed the Novice Puppy class or Novice Adult class, the terrier may not enter ANY Novice GTG class ever again.*
- Class 48 **Open Puppy** Open to Jack Russells 6 to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial **OR** may continue competing in Open Puppy Go to Ground class at future trials. **Open Puppy GTG is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.** (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another).

(One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry; may switch from one kind of work to another).

No adult terrier may compete in any GTG or Super Earth Certificate class unless a JRTCA Trial Certificate has been applied for, issued, AND presented to the Trial Secretary with the submission of entry forms or at the trial.

One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter earth several times until the quarry is reached then must work quarry for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. May switch from one type of work to another without penalty.

A copy of the certificate must be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and Second Place winners will be Under Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

DIVISION D: CHILD/YOUTH

**** NO ENTRY FEES ****

Child and Youth Handler classes will be the first Conformation classes in the ring. Child Handler is first, followed by Youth Handler. Note: Classes will run as a group after racing, please listen for the announcement to meet with the Youth Wrangler.

Child classes are open to members ages 5 through 9. Youth classes are open to members ages 10 through 16. The Child/Youth's age is determined by the age as of January 1st of current calendar year. Handlers must compete in both Child/Youth Handler and Child/Youth GTG to qualify for the Child/Youth High Score and Reserve. A tie will be broken by a handling class to be held in the conformation ring, with the judge to be decided by the trial administrator.

The Child/Youth Handler program must handle the SAME terrier in all the Child/Youth Division classes entered. The intention of this Division is for the Child/Youth to have a positive experience. They should have a basic knowledge of the history of the Jack Russell Terrier as well. This information is available on the Jack Russell Terrier Club Of America's website. www.therealjackrussell.com.

GTG Reminder

For those terriers entered in the Child/Youth Handler Division, Go-To-Ground Division, &/or Agility Division, please remember that the terrier **MUST** run their **SANCTIONED** Go-To-Ground &/or Agility class **BEFORE** the Child/Youth Handler Go-To-Ground & Agility classes.

Please Note: Child/Youth Classes are run TOGETHER, as a group, after racing.

Section 2: YOUTH HANDLER

- Class 74 **Youth Handler** Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of the Jack Russell Terrier. Quality of the dog is NOT to be considered.
