Sunday, May 24, is a Sanctioned Trial. You must be a current JRTCA member to enter sanctioned classes on Sunday. For classes that require certificates, Working, GTG and Super Earth, certificates must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries and/or available for ring steward. Trial Chair Mike Hayes

Membership: If you join Missouri Earthdogs, you enjoy discounted member rates on entry fees. Memberships are Individual \$20, Family \$25, or Youth \$10. To add your membership in Trial Vault, you can select from "Add-Ons".

PRE-ENTRY: The pre-entry deadline in Trial Vault is May 17. Mailed entries with a postmark date after May 12 will be considered post entries. Entries received or paid after the deadline will be considered post entries. Pre-entry fees for MOE members--\$13/class; Non-member pre-entry-\$16/class. Post entry fee are \$18/class.

Pre-entries are required for Friday Night and Sunday Racing, Jacks Are Wild! Poker, and Dutch Creek Challenge. No racing entries will be accepted after the pre-entry deadline or during the trial (except to fill heats).

Trial Vault: We are pleased to offer Trial Vault for entries and encourage you to use Trial Vault to make your online entries. The website is <https://www.v3.trialvault.dog> and there is no cost to create an account. If you prefer, you can fill out a manual entry form and send to the mailing address on the entry form. **Questions on entries or Trial Vault?** Please contact Tracy Flora at tracymoeearthdogs@gmail.com (314) 795-5410.

Payments: Payments can be made through PayPal to payment@moeearthdogs.org. There is a 3% convenience fee. You can add 3% to your total or pay the 3% at the trial when you pick up our packet. Checks (payable to Missouri Earthdogs) can be mailed to Tracy Flora, 1521 La Dina Place, Ellisville, MO 63011. Payment must be postmarked by May 12 for pre-entry rates.

Saturday Certificates: Saturday's Working Conformation classes require a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate, AWTA Working Certificate, a UKC Working Certificate or a valid working certificate from a working program for your breed. A copy of the certificate must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries and/or available for ring steward. If appropriate paperwork is not submitted, the dog will be bumped to Open. No refunds will be given.

Saturday Working classes: Because we feel strongly about the "working" part of our Memorial Day Bash, we have structured our Working classes to include other terriers. The Jack Russell Working Champion, as well as Working Other Terrier winners will move on to the Missouri Earthdogs Working Champion of Champions.

Saturday Working Ceremony: We recognize all Jack Russells, Other Earthworking terriers or Dachshunds who have received their JRTCA Bronze Medallion, JRTCA Working Achievement Award or AWTA Veteran Earthdog Award since June 2025. A ceremony/exhibition will be held immediately before Saturday's lunch break (approximately 12:00 pm). General Trial Rules – Friday & Saturday

- Classes are for Jack Russell Terriers, Parson Russell Terriers, Other Earthworking Terriers & Dachshunds only; except Lure Coursing, Barn Hunt, & Brush Hunt which are open to other breeds/mixes, also See Jack Run Tunnel (if they fit in a 9" tunnel),
- Parson Russells may enter Jack Russell classes.
- Other terriers and Dachshunds may only enter designated classes.
- ALL classes are open to intact and spayed/neutered terriers.
- Jack Russell or Parson Russell entries must be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard (with the exception of pups who have not yet reached 10" in height). Adults under 10" may be in Shorties classes. Measuring devices will be available.
- Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four month birthday (not 16 weeks) by the date of the trial.
- Bitches in season may not compete in any division and should not be brought to the trial site. Refunds will be provided with veterinarian documentation.
- Puppies under the age of three months are not allowed on the trial site or in RV camping areas.
- No puppy sales allowed on trial site. NO EXCEPTIONS! Anyone violating this rule will be excused from all classes, with no refunds, and asked to leave the trial site.
- Dogs must be free from contagious disease and current on vaccines.
- Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number, or by the Judge EXCEPT in racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if the classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of any under adult dog entered in Racing may call for measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races). Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. JRTCA height cards will be honored.
- Excessive use of baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the conformation ring and may result in the terrier being excused. "Excessive use" will be at the judge's discretion.
- Entries in the Working division of conformation **MUST** provide the appropriate paperwork with pre-entries and/or have it available for ring steward. If appropriate paperwork is not provided, the dog will be bumped to Open. No refunds will be given.
- Unsportsmanlike conduct will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site and no refunds will be given. "Unsportsmanlike" will be at the discretion of the trial committee/chairperson.
- Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control his/her dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the judges and/or trial committee/chairperson. Please remember that Purina Farms is a public place!
- Unclaimed ribbons will be available at the Trial office until the close of the trial on Sunday. No ribbons will be mailed.
- Please be understanding! Trial staff, volunteers, and winners of Raffle Butt Passes, may be bumped up in line at some events.
- The judges' decisions are final!

RACING RULES

- All entries must be muzzled. Only softy or basket muzzles are allowed. No open ended, figure eights or mikki muzzles. No colored muzzles. Black, brown, clear, or white muzzles are acceptable.
- Exhibitors must have entries ready to race, be aware of their classes, and be ready when called.
- Heats will be run as listed on heat sheets. No refunds or reruns for missed heats/classes.
- Once entries are loaded into the starting box, all handlers shall proceed to the finish line to be ready to receive their dogs.
- In a flat or hurdle race, any entry not wearing a secured muzzle, going around the jumps, or jumping out of the racetrack will be disqualified from the race and therefore shown as not finishing that race.
- Races will be rerun if the lure is caught. In all cases, reruns are at the discretion of the judge.
- Entries engaging in fighting will be disqualified from racing for the remainder of the day. No refunds will be given.
- Entries must cross the finish line completely; the finish line is the back of the barrier. First to the hole is not necessarily first *through* the hole.
- Racing champions are determined by run-offs of the first place terriers in appropriate age & height classes. To be eligible to run in the Championship race, a terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle race final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the backside of the barrier; A terrier **MUST ENTER AND FINISH** in both, at least one flat race **AND** one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final). A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final championship race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in the final. A **FINISHED** race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.
- Other Terriers & Dachshunds may only enter Other Terrier/Dachshund racing classes, except puppies. Parson Russells may enter Jack Russell classes.
- See General Rule regarding a size protest. Measurements must be requested and completed 30 minutes prior to the start of racing.
- No cross entering between Novice, Adult, Veteran or Senior racing classes.
- Novice racing classes are on Friday night only, 1-6 ribbons awarded, no championships.
- No racing entry may exceed 15".
- There is no entry fee for Championship Racing classes.

JRTCA General Rules For Exhibitors - Sunday

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10-15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 months) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Working and Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family* or Open Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division. (Exception - Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1)
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes, or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RVs and Campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds).
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Chairperson.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language, will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event.
24. THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.

You can enter as many dogs as you like. Each dog will have their own poker hand.
Participating dogs will receive a playing card for each class in which they are entered, including Sunday classes.
You need at least 2 cards per dog. NOT TO EXCEED 5 PLAYING CARDS PER DOG!

The dog with the best hand is the Winner!! Jacks ARE Wild!!

If you enter multiple dogs, you cannot combine cards to improve your poker hand. Cards will be issued for paid classes only.

The dog must be released after signal of the judge with all four feet on the ground and behind the line. Any violation, intentional or accidental, will result in disqualification.
- After the dog has been released, the handler shall remain next to the entrance hole. Commands and encouragement may be given.
- Any adult Earthworking Terrier or Dachshund that advances from their Open to their Championship class cannot enter the Open class at any future Missouri Earthdogs trial.

Pre-Novice Puppy – One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; work quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Class 228: Pre-Novice Puppy Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age.

Novice Puppy & Novice Adult – Once a puppy or adult pass a Novice class, they may never enter another Novice class again. One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Puppy Championship - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 233: Puppy Championship Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell puppies, 6 up to 12 months, which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. 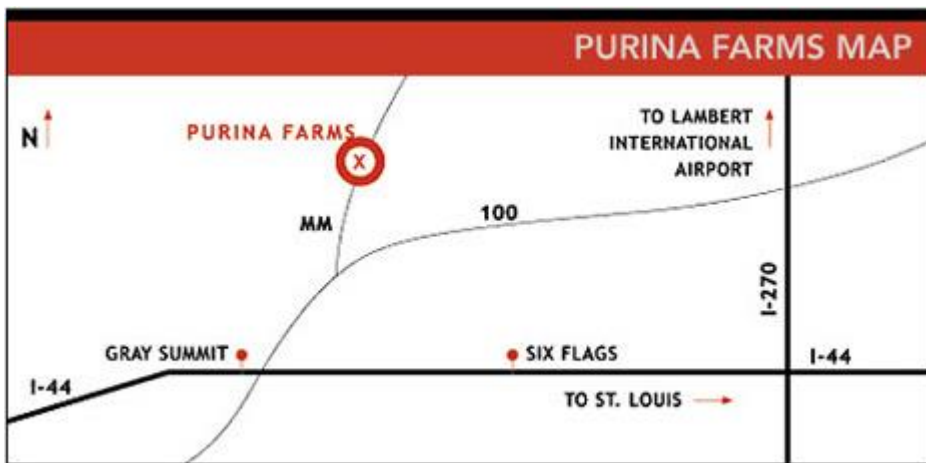

Directions to Purina Farms from St. Louis Airport:

From the St. Louis Airport, travel on I-70 west, take exit 232 to I-270 South toward Memphis. Take Exit 5B to I-44 West toward Tulsa. Take the exit 253 Gray Summit and turn right on Highway 100. Travel ½ mile to County Road MM. Turn left on Highway MM for 1 mile to entry gate on left.

From Downtown St. Louis:

Take I-44 West to Exit 253 -Gray Summit and turn right on Highway 100. Travel almost a ½ mile to County Road MM. Turn left on Hwy MM for 1 mile to entry gate on left.
