GENERAL RULES FOR EXHIBITORS

1. All sanctioned classes are open to Jack Russell Terriers only.
2. Exhibitors and owners of terriers entered must be current JRTCA members and not be a member of a conflicting JRT organization or register their JRTs in any all-breed registry or conflicting JRT registry. If an exhibitor is found to be in violation of this policy, entry will be disqualified and no refunds will be given. If a violation is confirmed after the trial, placements will be voided from all JRTCA records. Exhibitors must submit a completed entry form including a signed waiver for every trial they enter.
3. Entries MUST be within the 10 - 15" JRTCA height standard for all sanctioned classes (with the exception of pups who have not yet met the 10" height standard); measuring devices will be available on the trial grounds.
4. Puppies (under 12 mos) are not eligible for a championship in any division but their own. Puppies are eligible to compete only if they have reached their four-month birthday (not 16 weeks). A puppy's age is the actual age the pup is on the day of the trial.
5. Bitches in season may not compete in any division. Pre-entry fees of bitches in season will be refunded with a veterinarian certificate, or as otherwise agreed upon by the Trial Chairperson.
6. Spayed or neutered terriers may compete in Working and Miscellaneous Conformation. They may not compete in Puppy, Family* or Open Conformation. *Note: For Family Classes, Brood Bitches and Stud Dogs entered may not be spayed/neutered. The offspring at their sides may be intact or spayed/neutered.
7. A terrier bred by a sanctioned JRTCA Judge may not be shown under that Judge in the conformation division.
8. Terriers owned or co-owned by the Trial Chairperson, or any member of their household, may not be entered in any phase of the competition, with the exception of Child and Youth Handling.
9. Terriers owned by judges may not be entered in the division or section in which they are judging but may enter the competition in any other division. (Exception - Ring 2 Nationals judge may have terriers shown in Ring 1)
10. Terriers owned by stewards may be entered in any division provided that they find a substitute to perform their duties or have someone else show their terriers.
11. Requests for the measurement of a terrier entered in any class number may be made only by another exhibitor in that same class number or by the Judge EXCEPT in Racing. Requests for the measurement of a terrier in Racing may be made by the Judge or by an exhibitor with a terrier entered in the same class number; OR, if classes are split by gender, may call for the measurement of a terrier of the opposite gender in the same age and height category. (Example: The owner of an under adult dog entered in Racing may call for the measurement of an under adult bitch as the potential exists for them to race each other in the Championship Races.) Exhibitors racing puppies may call for the measurement of a puppy in a different age category as long as it is in the same height category. The person making the request for measurement must name the terrier or terriers they wish to have measured, but requests for measurement of entire classes will not be honored. The measurement of the terrier will be considered the terrier's official height for the duration of the trial. Only JRTCA height cards issued after September, 1999 will be honored.
12. Excessive use of squeaky or fur-like baiting devices by exhibitors is prohibited in the Conformation ring and may result in the exhibitor being excused from the class. "Excessive use" will be at the Judge's discretion.
13. Exhibitors participating in the JRTCA Working Terrier classes, or Certificate Go-To-Ground and Super Earth must submit the appropriate JRTCA certificates with pre-entries or at the time of post-entry. The Judge may require a copy of the certificate be presented to the Ring/Den steward at time of judging. Registered terriers may submit a copy of NHC application signed by a JRTCA Working Judge within 30 days of the date it was issued.
14. Puppies under the age of three months are not permitted on the trial grounds. Any person violating this rule will be excused from all classes entered and asked to leave the trial site. (This applies to RV's and Campers, if at the same address as the trial grounds).
15. All dogs must be leashed or crated except when competition requires off-leash work. No liberty leashes allowed.
16. Overly aggressive dogs, or an owner's failure to control their dog, may result in disqualification at the discretion of the Judges or the Trial Administrator.
17. The abuse or severe disciplining of dogs on the trial grounds is prohibited. Anyone displaying such behavior will be asked to leave the trial site, and no entry fees will be refunded.
18. Dogs other than JRTs on the grounds may be excluded or permitted at the discretion of the Trial Chairperson.
19. Exhibitors are responsible to double check the classes they have entered and be on time. No refunds will be given for missed classes.
20. The owner/handler of a terrier entering any class does so at his/her own risk and agrees to abide by the rules of the JRTCA and the trial. A copy of the JRTCA Rule Book can be downloaded from the JRTCA website (www.therealjackrussell.com).
21. Unsportsmanlike conduct, or the use of foul and abusive language will not be tolerated. Anyone demonstrating such conduct will be asked to leave the trial site and no entry fees will be refunded. In addition, such conduct will be subject to penalties which may include the suspension of membership, restriction from entering the JRTCA National Trial, and/or fines. Trial Chairpersons have the right to refuse any entry at their discretion.
22. All dogs brought to the trial must be current on vaccinations. No dogs of any age may be brought to a trial who have suspicion of contagious or infectious disease.
23. Judges may not eat, smoke, vape, or use cell phones while judging their event.
24. **THE JUDGES' DECISIONS ARE FINAL IN ALL DIVISIONS.**

Racing

No post entries in racing, except to fill heats. Racing begins promptly at 8:00 am. Height calls by 7:30am.

*****ALL TERRIERS MUST BE MUZZLED!** Plastic muzzles or close-ended cloth muzzles only. No figure eight or open-ended muzzles are allowed. Black, brown, clear, or white muzzles are acceptable; no colored basket or softie muzzles are allowed.*** To qualify for Championship run offs, a terrier must place first in a flat or hurdle race final to qualify for championship run offs. First to the hole is not necessarily first through the backside of the barrier; A terrier **MUST ENTER AND FINISH** in both, at least one flat race **AND** one hurdle race at the beginning level based on trial entries (heat, semi, final). A terrier must continue to advance, if qualified, to all additional semi-final heats up to the final championship race. If injured, the terrier is then finished and cannot race in the final. A **FINISHED** race is when the terrier runs down the track unassisted (by owner or anyone else) with a secured muzzle to the backside of the barrier. In the event a terrier does not meet all the above criteria, the second place terrier in the final of that class (either flats or hurdles) will qualify for the championship run off if they meet the criteria as outlined above.

Class 31: 10” up to 12 ½” Senior Racing Championship, Open to 1st place winners of classes 6, 8, 25 and 27. No entry fee

Class 32: Over 12½” up to 15” Senior Racing Championship, Open to 1st place winners of classes 7, 9, 26 & 28. No entry fee

Adult Steeplechase Races over higher hurdles, over 8" up to 16"

Class 33: Dogs, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 ½"

Class 34: Dogs, 1 year and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 35: Bitches, 1 year and older, 10" up to 12 ½"

Class 36: Bitches, 1 year and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 37: Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"

Class 38: Veteran Dogs, 6 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 39: Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, 10" up to 12 ½"

Class 40: Veteran Bitches, 6 years and older, over 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 43: 10" up to 12 ½" Veteran Racing Championship, Open to 1st place winners of classes 14, 16, 37 & 39. No entry fee

Class 44: Over 12½ up to 15" Veteran Racing Championship, Open to 1st place winners of classes 15, 17, 38 & 40. No entry fee

Other Terriers

Class 45: Other Terriers, 6 up to 12 months, up to 15" (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 46: Other Terriers, 1 year and older, up to 12 ½" (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 47: Other Terriers, 1 year and older, over 12 ½" up to 15" (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 48: Other Terrier Racing Best & Reserve, up to 12 ½", Open to 1st place winners of classes 19 & 46. No entry fee

Class 49: Other Terrier Racing Best & Reserve, over 12 ½" up to 15", Open to 1st place winners of classes 20 & 47. No entry fee

Youth

Terriers competing in Child or Youth GTG, if entered in regular GTG classes, must compete in the regular GTG class prior to competing in the Child or Youth GTG class. The same terrier must be handled in both the Handler and Go-to-Ground classes.

Class 50 Child Handler: Open to any youth aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT 6 months of age or older. This class is offered as an introductory experience in handling and learning about the Jack Russell Terrier. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell. Quality of the dog NOT to be considered.

Class 51 Child Handler Go-To-Ground: (Non-Sanctioned) Open to any child aged 5 through 9, handling a JRT 6 months of age or older. Judged on the child's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-to-Ground. To be run through the 10 foot Novice liner; time not to be considered. Parent or adult help is permitted and encouraged for very young children

Class 52 Child Handler High Score and Reserve: (Non-Sanctioned) Awarded to the highest scoring child and runner –up in classes 50 and 51. Points are awarded as follow: 1st= 8 points, 2nd= 6 points; 3rd= 5 points, 4th= 4points, 5th= 3 points, 6th= 2 points and participation = 1 point.

Class 53 Youth Handler: Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's beginning knowledge of the Jack Russell and ability to present his/her dog. Quality of dog NOT to be considered.

Class 54 Youth Working Judge's Choice: Open to any youth handler aged 10-16 handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's knowledge of hunting and the working terrier, and ability to answer questions presented by a JRTCA Working Judge; no terrier to accompany handler in class.

Class 55 Youth Go-To-Ground: Open to any youth aged 10 through 16, handling an adult JRT. Judged on the youth's ability to present his/her dog and knowledge of Go-To-Ground. To be run through the 10 foot Novice liner; time not to be considered.

Class 56 Youth Handler High Score & Reserve: Awarded to the highest scoring youth and runner-up in classes 53, 54 and 55. The points are awarded as follows: 1st = 8 points; 2nd = 6 points; 3rd = 5 points; 4th = 4 points; 5th= 3 points, 6th= 2 points and participation =1 point.

Conformation

Working Terrier Conformation

Open to any JRTCA registered terrier owned by a JRCTA member which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate. Terriers entering the Working section may not cross-enter into the Open section; no cross-entering is permitted within the working section. Classes will be split by coat if entries warrant.

Class 57: Bronze Medallion Dog: Open to any dog which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for Special Merit in the Field.

Class 58: Working Terrier Dog: 10" up to 12½"

Class 59: Working Terrier Dog: over 12½ up to 15"

Class 60: Working Neutered Terrier Dog Open to any neutered JR, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate.

Class 61: Best Working Terrier Dog & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 57-60. (No entry fee)

Class 62: Bronze Medallion Bitch: Open to any Bitch which has earned the JRTCA Bronze Medallion for special merit in the field.

Class 63: Best Bronze Medallion: Open to 1st & 2nd place winners of classes 57 & 62. (No entry fee) Non-Sanctioned

Class 64: Working Terrier Bitch: 10" up to 12½"

Class 65: Working Terrier Bitch: over 12½ up to 15"

Class 66: Working Spayed Terrier Bitch Open to any spayed JR, which holds a JRTCA Natural Hunting Certificate.

Class 67: Best Working Terrier Bitch & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 62, 64, 65 and 66. (No entry fee)

Class 68: Working Terrier Conformation Champion & Reserve: Open to Best Working Terrier Dog and Reserve and Best Working Bitch and Reserve of class 61 & 67. (No entry fee)

Miscellaneous - Open to Adult Spayed and Neutered Terriers

Class 69: Neutered Adult Dog: Open to any Jack Russell, 1 year of age or older, that has been neutered.

Class 70: Spayed Adult Bitch: Open to any Jack Russell, 1 year of age or older, that has been spayed.

Class 71: Veteran Dog: Open to any Jack Russell dog, 6 years of age or older.

Class 72: Veteran Bitch: Open to any Jack Russell bitch, 6 years of age or older.

Class 73: Best Veteran Terrier & Reserve: Open to first and second place winners of classes 71 & 72. (No entry fee)

Class 74: Costume (Non-Sanctioned) Open to all breeds. Judged on originality and creativity.

Class 75: Tricks (Non-Sanctioned) Open to all breeds. Judged on cuteness and creativity.

Other Terriers (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 76: Other Earthworking Terrier Puppies, 4-12 months

Class 77: Other Earthworking Terrier Dog, 1 year of age or older

Class 78: Other Earthworking Terrier Bitch, 1 year of age or older

Class 79: Best Other Earthworking Terrier & Reserve: Open to first and second place winners of classes 76-86 (No entry fee)

Suitability "Judges Choice": Open to any adult Jack Russell Terrier, including those which have been spayed/neutered. The dog the judge would choose to take hunting to each quarry listed below.

Class 80: Suitability to Red Fox

Class 81: Suitability to Groundhog

Class 82: Suitability to Raccoon/Badger

Class 83: Tool Box: Open to handler with three adult Jack Russell Terriers at side; one suitable to each quarry (Fox, groundhog, raccoon/badger) Placement based on the group the judge would choose to take hunting.

Family (Note: Stud Dog and Brood Bitch must be intact. Offspring may be intact, spayed or neutered.)

Class 84: Stud Dog & Get: Open to Sire with at least 2, but not more than 3 offspring at parent's side. Stud dog must be an intact male. Offspring may be intact or spayed/neutered. Judged on breed standard and consistency of type.

Class 85: Brood Bitch & Produce: Open to dam with at least 2, but not more than 3 offspring at parent's side. Brood Bitch must be an intact female. Offspring may be intact, spayed or neutered. Judged on breed standard and consistency of type.

Class 86: Best Family & Reserve: Open to the first & second place winners of classes 84 & 85. (No entry fee.)

Class 87: Three Generations Open to a minimum of three successive generations of breeding; the second and successive generations must be bred by the exhibitor

3 up to 4 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 88: 3 up to 4 Month Puppy (Non-Sanctioned)

4 up to 6 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 89: Dog pups: 4 up to 6 months

Class 90: Bitch pups: 4 up to 6 months

Class 91: Best 4 up to 6 Month Puppy & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 89 & 90. (No entry fee).

6 up to 12 Month Puppy Conformation

Class 92: Dog pups: 6 up to 9 months

Class 93: Dog pups: 9 up to 12 months

Class 94: Best Dog Puppy & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 92 & 93. (No entry fee)

Class 95: Bitch pups: 6 up to 9 months

Class 96: Bitch pups: 9 up to 12 months

Class 97: Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 95 & 96. (No entry fee)

Class 98: Puppy Champion & Reserve: Open to Best Dog Puppy & Reserve and Best Bitch Puppy & Reserve of classes 94 & 97. (No entry fee)

Open Adult Conformation

No Cross-entering is permitted within the Open Section. Cross-entering is not permitted between the Open division and the Working Division.

Class 99: Bred by Exhibitor Dog: Open to any Jack Russell Terrier Dog owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder *under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered* or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 100: Dogs: 1 year & older, 10" up to 12 ½"

Class 101: Dogs: 1 year & older, over 12½ up to 15"

Class 102: Best Open Dog & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 99-101. (No entry fee)

Class 103: Bred by Exhibitor Bitch: Open to any Jack Russell Terrier Bitch owned and bred by the exhibitor; must be handled by the breeder *under whose kennel prefix the terrier is registered* or a member of the breeder's immediate family.

Class 104: Bitches: 1 year & older, over 10" up to 12 ½"

Class 105: Bitches: 1 year & older, over 12 ½" up to 15"

Class 106: Best Open Bitch & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 103-104. (No entry fee)

Class 107: Best Open Terrier & Reserve: Open to 1st and 2nd place winners of classes 102 & 106. (No entry fee)

Class 108: Best of the Best & Reserve (Non-Sanctioned) Open to Champion & Reserve Champion Working Terrier; Best Veteran Terrier & Reserve; Best Other Terrier & Reserve; 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Champion & Reserve; Best Open Terrier & Reserve (No entry fee)

Go-To-Ground

A timed event that simulates the terrier's natural instinct to hunt. The terrier enters an artificial den/tunnel to demonstrate its working ability. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Class 109: Pre-Novice Puppy Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russell puppies 4 up to 6 months. Entry in Pre-Novice Puppy class does not affect the puppy's eligibility to enter the Novice Class after 6 months of age. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter until quarry is reached; mark quarry for 15 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.)

Novice Puppy & Novice Adult - One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; must work quarry for 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 110: Novice Puppy Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Puppy Class at this trial.

Class 111: Novice Adult Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russells one year of age or older which have not scored 100% in this class at a previous JRTCA trial. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial

Open Puppy & Open Adult - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; must work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 112: Open Puppy Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russells 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. **Not open to any puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship GTG.** Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship GTG class at this trial or may continue competing in Open Puppy GTG class at future trials.

Class 113: Open Adult Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russells one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial.

Puppy Championship - One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter once until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 114: Puppy Championship Go-To-Ground: Open to Jack Russells, 6 up to 12 months which have earned 100% in an Open Go-To-Ground class at this or a previous JRTCA trial. A copy of a 100% Open score sheet shall be submitted with pre-entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve. Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship GTG, they cannot return to Open.

Championship Certificate Classes – For Championship Certificate classes, a copy of the certificate must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries or shown to the Den Steward at the trial. No cross entering between Certificate classes. One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may not leave the earth; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.

Class 115: 10" up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell 10" up to 12½", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Under Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 116: Over 12½" up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12½" up to 15", one year and over, which holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Over Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 117: 10" up to 12½" Veteran Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell 10" up to 12½", 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Under Veteran Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 118: Over 12½" up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12½" up to 15", 6 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Over Veteran Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 119: 10" up to 12 ½" Senior Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell 10" up to 12½", 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Under Senior Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Class 120: Over 12 ½" up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate Go-To-Ground: Open to any adult Jack Russell over 12½" up to 15", 9 years of age or older, who holds a JRTCA Trial Certificate. First and second place winners will be Over Senior Go-To-Ground Champion and Reserve.

Other Terrier Go-to-Ground (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 121: Other Terrier Novice Puppy: Open to Other Earthworking Terriers 6 up to 12 months which have not scored 100% in this class. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open Other Terrier Puppy Class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached, must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.) (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 122: Other Terrier Novice Adult: Open to Other Earthworking Terriers one year or older which have not scored 100% in this class. Entries earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Open class at this trial. (One minute to reach quarry; may leave earth and re-enter several times until quarry is reached; when quarry is reached must work quarry continuously for a full 30 seconds without a break in work and without leaving the quarry.) (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 123: Other Terrier Open Puppy: Open to Other Earthworking Terriers 6 up to 12 months which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.) (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 124: Other Terrier Open Adult: Open to Other Earthworking Terriers one year or older which have scored 100% in a Novice Go-To-Ground class. (One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave earth once and re-enter before the quarry is reached; must work quarry continuously for one full minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry.) (Non-Sanctioned)

Super Earth

A challenging GTG course with a series of false entrances and/or false tunnels and dens. Open to any Jack Russell Terrier, 6 months and older. Schooling prior to the competition is not permitted. Terrier may switch from one type of work to another (examples: baying to concentrated stare or digging to baying.)

Timing for all Super Earth classes: One second per foot of tunnel to reach quarry; may leave and re-enter the earth multiple times until quarry is reached; work quarry for one minute without a break in work and without leaving quarry. Terrier is not to leave quarry once it is reached.

Class 125: Open Puppy 6 up to 12 month Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terrier puppies, 6 up to 12 months. Puppies earning a score of 100% at this trial may, upon payment of the entry fee, enter the Puppy Championship Super Earth class at this trial OR may continue competing in Open Puppy Super Earth class at future trials. Open Puppy Super Earth is not open to any Puppy which has competed in Puppy Championship Super Earth.

Class 126: 10" up to 12½" Open Adult Super Earth: Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 127: Over 12½" up to 15" Open Adult Super Earth: Open to terriers one year and older.

Class 128: 10" up to 12½" Open Veteran Super Earth: Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 129: Over 12½" up to 15" Open Veteran Super Earth: Open to terriers six years and older.

Class 130: 10" up to 12½" Open Senior Super Earth: Open to terriers nine years and older.

Class 131: Over 12½" up to 15" Open Senior Super Earth: Open to terriers nine years and older.

Class 132: 6 up to 12 Month Puppy Championship Super Earth. Open to 6 up to 12 month JRT puppies which have earned 100% in an Open 6 up to 12 Month Super Earth Puppy Class at this or a previous JRTCA Trial. A copy of a 100% score sheet must be presented with Pre-Entry or be shown to the Den Steward at the time of the class. First and second place winners will be Puppy Super Earth Champion and Reserve. Once a puppy competes in Puppy Championship SE, they cannot return to Open.

Championship Certificate Classes: For Championship Certificate classes, a copy of the certificate must be on file in Trial Vault, included with your entries or shown to the Den Steward at the trial. No cross entering between Certificate classes.

Class 133: 10" up to 12½" Adult Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers 10" up to 12½", one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. First and Second Place winners will be Under Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 134: Over 12½" up to 15" Adult Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers over 12½" up to 15", one year and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. First and Second Place winners will be Over Adult Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 135: 10" up to 12½" Veteran Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers 10" up to 12½", six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. First and Second Place winners will be Under Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 136: Over 12½" up to 15" Veteran Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers over 12½" up to 15", six years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. First and Second Place winners will be Over Veteran Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 137: 10" up to 12½" Senior Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers 10" up to 12½", nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. First and Second Place winners will be Under Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Class 138: Over 12½" up to 15" Senior Championship Certificate Super Earth: Open to Jack Russell Terriers over 12½" up to 15", nine years and older, which hold a JRTCA Super Earth Trial Certificate. First and Second Place winners will be Over Senior Super Earth Champion and Reserve.

Other Terrier Super Earth (Non-Sanctioned)

Class 139: Other Terrier Puppy: Open to Other Earthworking Terriers 6 up to 12 months.

Class 140: Other Terrier Adult, 10" up to 12½": Open to Other Earthworking Terriers

Class 141: Other Terrier Adult, Over 12½" up to 15": Open to Other Earthworking Terriers

Rat Hunt (Non-Sanctioned)

Classes open to Jack Russells and Other Terriers

Class 142: Puppies, 4 up to 12 months

Class 143: Adults, one year and older

Class 144: Veterans, six years and older

Class 145: Seniors, nine years and older

Class 146: Super Seniors, eleven years and older

Class 147: Barn Hunt Best & Reserve, Fastest time & reserve from classes 142-146

Lure Coursing (Non-Sanctioned)

Timed event with the terrier chasing the lure. Entry includes two runs. The best time of two runs counts toward ribbon placement.

Classes open to Jack Russells and Other Terriers

Class 148: Puppies, 6 up to 12 months

Class 149: Adults, one year and older

Class 150: Veterans, six years and older

Class 151: Seniors, nine years and older

Class 152: Super Seniors, eleven years and older

Class 153: Lure Coursing Best & Reserve, Fastest time & reserve from classes 148-152

Nosework

Nosework taps into a dog's natural hunting instinct. When dogs use their sense of smell they engage their brain which is stimulating for them. Terrier Nosework Title (TNT) is open to dogs six months and older. After some initial training that gives the target odor value, dogs enjoy being the leader of the scent detection team.

Saturday 12:00pm – 2:00pm approximately

Class 154: Level 2 Containers: 10 – 14 containers with 2 hides of either birch, anise or clove, 2:30 minutes, on leash. Handler must call finish to stop time. Containers may or may not be identical and may be elevated up to 2 feet high. Qualifying faults that add 5 seconds each to time: not going through start cones, dropped food, excessive disturbance of search area. Failure to call finish results in full time. NQ for fouling the search area, incorrect call, or going over time. Placements for fastest time with no faults.

Class 155: Level 2 Exteriors: 2 hides of either birch, anise or clove, 2:30 – 4 min per Judge. On or off leash per Judge. Hides may be up to 2 feet off the ground. Qualifying faults that add 5 seconds each to time: not going through start cones, dropped food, excessive disturbance of search area. Failure to call finish results in full time. NQ for fouling the search area, incorrect call, or going over time. Placements for fastest time with no faults.

Class 157: Nosework Level 2 High Score Champion and Reserve

Champion and Reserve for combined scores from classes 154 & 155

Terrier High Point Awards (Non-Sanctioned)

This award will be given to the terrier (puppies or adults) earning the most TOTAL points each day. Only one (1) result from each division will be counted, with the exception of Racing – Flats and Hurdles will each be counted.

Champion and Reserve will be awarded each day!

Qualifying Divisions will be Racing Flats, Racing Hurdles, Go-to-Ground (Open or Championship tunnels), Super Earth, Rat Hunt, Lure Coursing & Nosework

There will be a score sheet for each entered terrier included in your packet. Owners will be responsible for tracking and totaling their own dog's points and turning them in to the Trial Secretary when they have completed competition.

1st – 8 pts, 2nd - 6 pts, 3rd - 5 pts, 4th - 4 pts, 5th - 3 pts, 6th - 2 pts, Participation - 1 pt.
Points will be verified. Ties will be broken by GTG times.

Terriers MUST be entered for High Point in Trial Vault or on paper entry form. Terrier puppies & adults are eligible. (Non-Sanctioned)
